The first league meeting will be held at the Marietta Community House, 264 W. Market Street, starting at 1:30 p.m. on Sunday, September 12. Any inter-

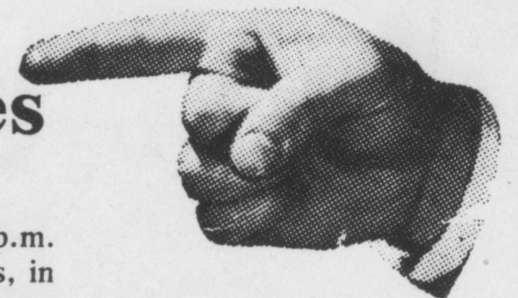
ested individual 18 years or older who resides in the Donegal School District is asked to attend. New and former teams from the district are also asked to have their representatives attend.

Boy Scouts to hold paper drive Sat.

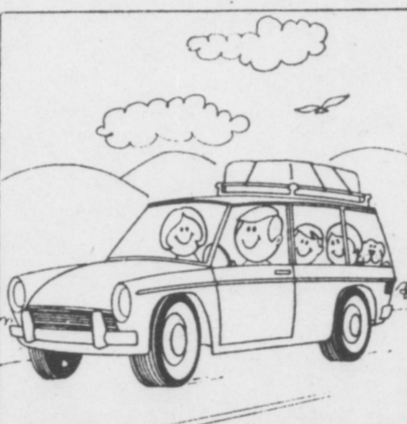
