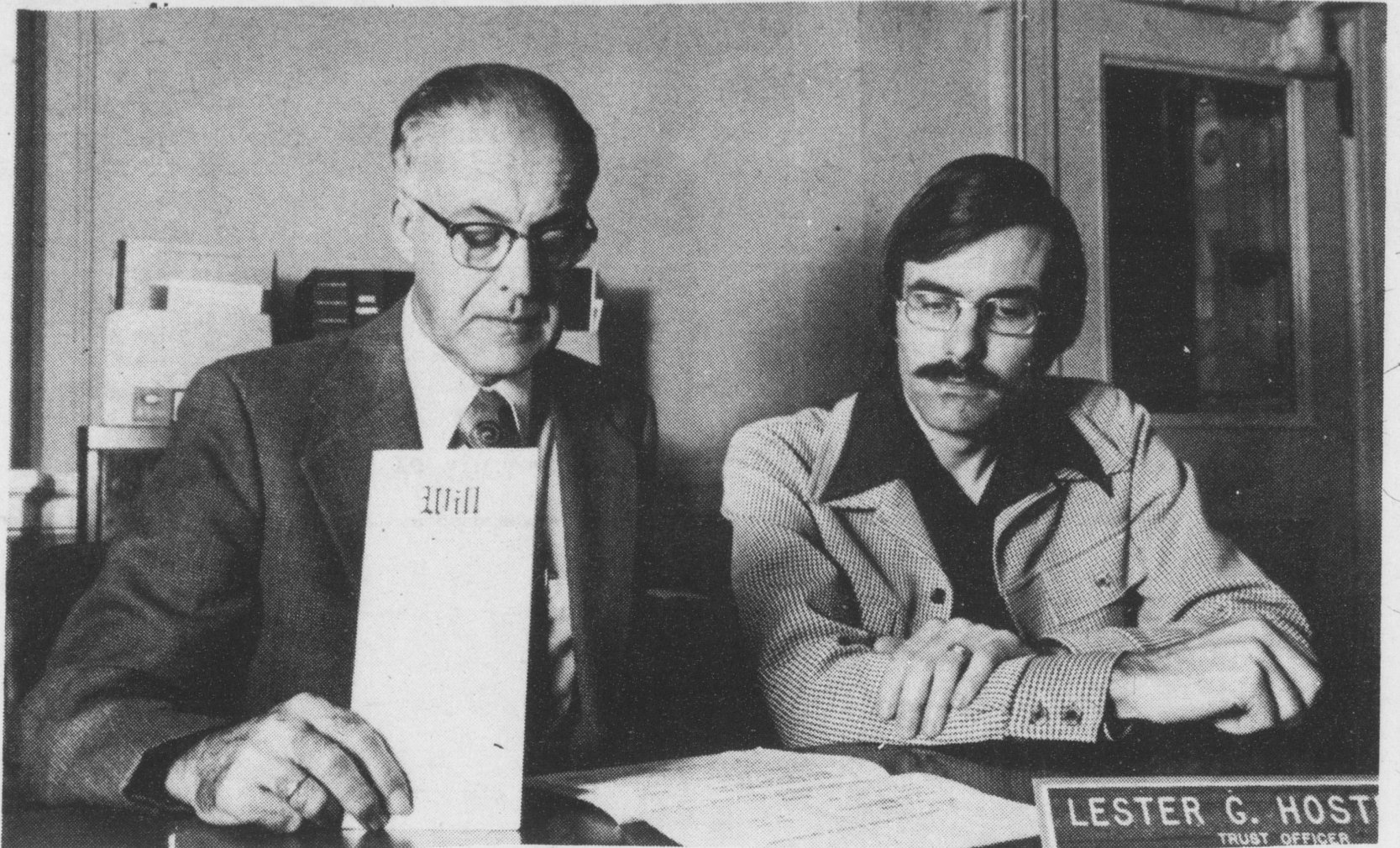


Floyd E. Shuman of R.D. #1, Marietta is shown holding his 33 inch carp. The big fish weighed 22 3/4 lbs.

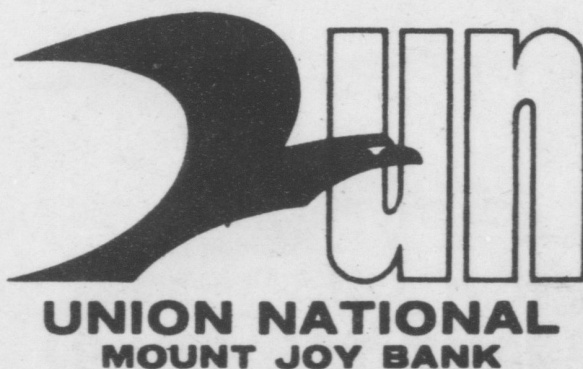

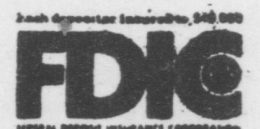
