#### **CHARLES T. GARRISON**

Charles T. Garrison, Manheim R5, was pronounced dead at 7:20 a.m., Sunday at Lancaster General Hospital about six hours after the car he was driving went out of control and struck a tree along Elizabethtown Road.

State police said Garrison was driving his car east on Elizabethtown Road about 1:45 a.m. The car went off the south berm and struck a tree head-on.

State police, who were assisted by Manheim Fire Company and Manheim Rescue Crew, estimated damage to Garrison's car at \$1,200.

Born in Hershey, Garrison was the son of Charles T. Garrison Sr., Marietta, and Shirley Landvater Garrison, Penryn.

A 1974 graduate of Manheim Central High School, he was employed as a mixer in the paint shop of Woodstream Corp., Lititz.

He was a member of Congregational Bible Church, Marietta.




