

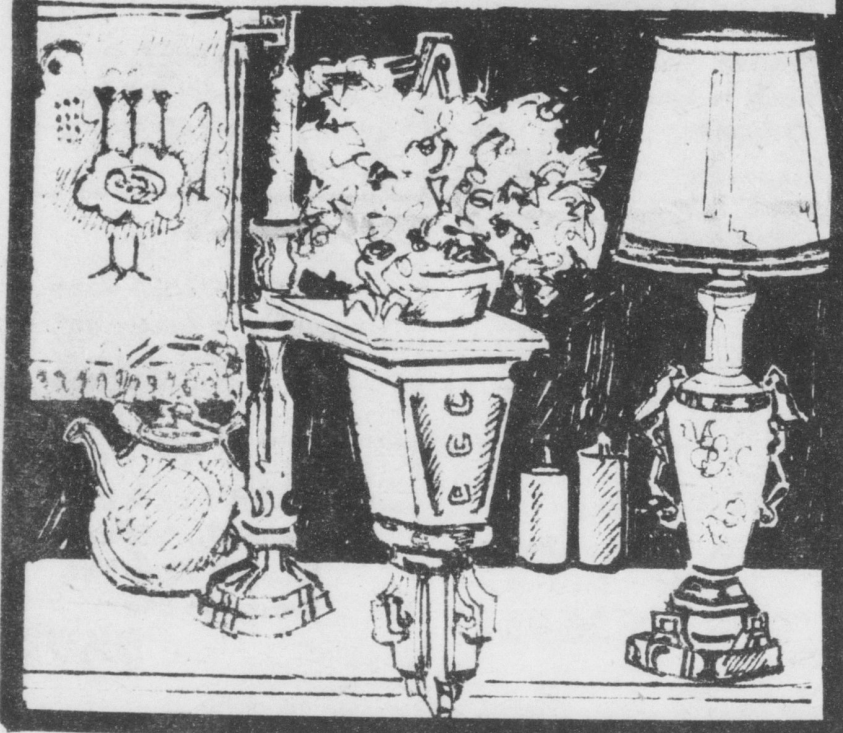

1. Review the proposed sketch plan of George Greenberg for the location of single-family semi-detached dwellings in an

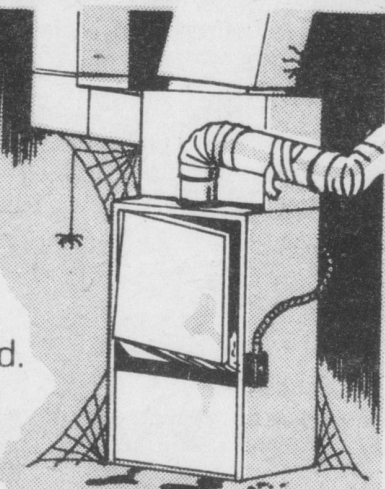
11.6 acre tract of land along Lefever Road.

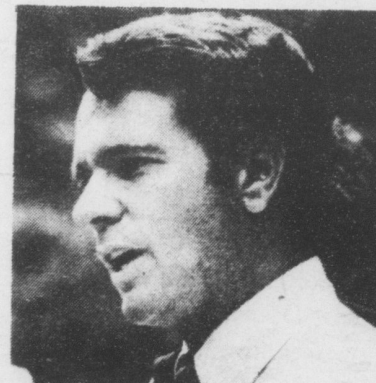
