ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING INCURRING OF LEASE RENTAL DEBT OF THE BOROUGH OF MOUNT JOY IN AN AMOUNT UP TO \$2,780,000 BY GUARANTEEING PAYMENT OF PRINCIPAL OF AND INTEREST ON MOUNT JOY BOROUGH AUTHORITY GUARANTEED WATER REVENUE BONDS, SERIES OF 1976, ISSUED FOR THE PURPOSE OF PROVIDING FUNDS FOR AND TOWARD REFUNDING ALL OF THE AUTHORITY'S OUTSTANDING WATER REVENUE BONDS, SERIES OF 1954, AND WATER REVENUE BONDS, SERIES OF 1966, AND FOR THE CONSTRUCTING AND EQUIPPING OF CERTAIN IMPROVEMENTS TO THE AUTHORITY'S WATER SYSTEM; AUTHORIZING EXECUTION AND DELIVERY OF A GUARANTY AGREEMENT; FIXING AMOUNT OF ANNUAL PAYMENTS OF PRINCIPAL OF AND INTEREST ON THE BONDS GUARANTEED BY THE BOROUGH; AUTHORIZING FILING OF DEBT STATEMENT, BORROWING BASE CERTIFICATE, TRANSCRIPT OF PROCEEDINGS AND APPLICATION FOR APPROVAL OF PENNSYLVANIA DEPARTMENT OF COMMUNITY AFFAIRS; AND APPROVING ENGINEERING REPORT OF GANNETT

RESOLUTION OF EAST
DONEGAL SEWER
AUTHORITY**

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of the Township of East Donegal, Lancaster County, Pennsylvania on April 24, 1969 enacted an ordinance (Ordinance NO. 5-1969) requiring owners of properties which have a principal building within 150 feet from the sewer system to connect to said system; and WHEREAS, the ordinance provides that the cost of connection shall be borne by the owner of the improved property; and WHEREAS, the ordinance further provides for the adoption of additional rules and regulations to implement the ordinance so enacted; and WHEREAS, the Authority by law may charge appropriate connection fees and tapping fees to owners of improved properties required to connect to the system;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it:

1. RESOLVED, that prior to obtaining a permit, in addition to all other requirements of the ordinance, an owner desiring to or required to connect to the sewer system shall have paid a fee, called a "connection fee," in the amount of One Hundred Seventy-Five Dollars (\$175).

2. RESOLVED, that the owner of any improved property desiring or required to connect to the sewer system shall be responsible for and shall pay

WHEREAS, the Borough Council of the Borough of Mount Joy (the "Borough"), has previously indicated its intention to guarantee payment of principal of and interest on Guaranteed Water Revenue Bonds, Series of 1976, of Mount Joy Borough Authority (the "Authority") to be issued for the purposes stated in the caption and Section 1 hereof, by execution of a Guaranty Agreement to be dated as of December 1, 1976 (the "Guaranty Agreement") to secure an issue of Guaranteed Water Revenue Bonds, Series of 1976, of the Authority having a term of 30 years in an amount up to \$2,780,000, to be issued in the denomination of \$5,000 and \$100 each; and

WHEREAS, there has been submitted to this meeting a form of the Guaranty Agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ENACTED AND ORDAINED BY THE BOROUGH COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF MOUNT JOY, PENNSYLVANIA, that:

1. The authorized debt of the Borough is hereby increased in an amount up to \$2,780,000, consisting of Lease Rental Debt (as defined in the Local Government Unit Debt Act, No. 185 of 1972, which as amended is herein termed the "act"), which, together with any other Lease Rental Debt and other debt of the Borough now existing, will not result in a violation of the limitations of

a "tapping fee" consisting of the difference between the total actual cost of work required to complete connection of the improved property to the sewer system in compliance with the ordinance and the One Hundred Seventy-Five Dollar (\$175) "connection fee" advanced for a permit, it being the intention of this resolution that all charges to connect to the system shall be borne by the owner.

3. RESOLVED, that upon demand and failure of any such property owner to pay the "connection fee" and "tapping fee", the Authority shall enforce payment thereof by municipal lien filed against said property and its owner or reputed owner, or by any other process authorized by law.

We, Lewis H. Sperla, Michael J. Pricio, John H. Hoffman, Jr., M. Helen Hollenbaugh, and John E. Zeller, as members of the East Donegal Sewer Authority as presently constituted, do by this writing consent to adopt the above resolutions.

RESOLVED FURTHER, that this consent be filed in the minutes of the proceedings of the Authority with the Secretary.

the Constitution of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania or of the Act. Said Lease Rental Debt is to be incurred by guaranteeing payment of the principal of and interest on the Authority's Guaranteed Water Revenue Bonds, Series of 1976, issued for the purpose of providing funds for and toward refunding all of the \$485,000 aggregate principal amount of Authority's Water Revenue Bonds, Series of 1954, and Water Revenue Bonds, Series of 1966, presently outstanding and for constructing and equipping improvements to the Authority's existing water system (such construction and equipping being herein called the "Project").

2. The maximum amount of Authority's Guaranteed Water Revenue Bonds, Series of 1976, to be secured by the Guaranty Agreement is \$2,780,000. Such Bonds are to be issued under the Authority's Trust Indenture dated as of December 1, 1976, which provides that such Bonds shall be secured by the pledge of revenues derived by the Authority from its water system and guaranteed by the Guaranty Agreement.

3. The above-mentioned debt to be incurred by the Borough shall be Lease Rental Debt.

4. The Guaranty Agreement is hereby approved in substantially the form presented to this meeting, with such changes, if any, as may be approved by the officers of the Borough Council executing it, whose execution thereof shall be conclusive evidence of such approval. The President or any Vice President of the Borough Council is hereby authorized and directed to execute the Guaranty Agreement on behalf of the Borough with any above-mentioned changes, and the Secretary of the Borough Council is hereby authorized and directed to affix thereto and attest the seal of the Borough, and then to deliver the Guaranty Agreement on behalf of the Borough.

5. The principal of and interest on the Authority's Guaranteed Water Revenue Bonds, Series of 1976, are to be payable from the revenues derived from the operation of the Authority's water system. The annual payments of principal and interest guaranteed by the Borough are the following:

6. The estimated useful life of the Project is not less than 30 years.	

7. The President or any Vice President of the Borough Council is hereby authorized and directed to prepare, execute and file with the Department of Community Affairs of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania the Debt Statement of the Borough required by Section 410 of the Act with an appended Borrowing Base Certificate, certified by the Borough Auditors, and all other documents required by the Act in connection with the execution and delivery of the Guaranty Agreement and such officers are hereby authorized to prepare and file any statements required by Article II of the Act necessary to qualify the debt of up to \$2,780,000 for exclusion from the appropriate debt limit of the Borough as self-liquidating debt. The proper officers of the Borough are hereby authorized and empowered to take all such further action and execute such additional documents as they may deem appropriate to carry out the purposes of this

Ordinance.

8. The engineering report of Gannett Fleming Corrdry and Carpenter, Inc., the Authority's Consulting Engineers, given pursuant to Section 206 of the Act, with respect to the improvements to the water system to be constructed and equipped by the Authority is hereby approved.

9. This Ordinance shall become effective on the earliest date permitted by the Act.

10. If any part of this Ordinance shall be held to be illegal or invalid, that shall not affect any other parts hereof, all of which shall be construed as if the illegal or invalid part had not been included herein.

11. All ordinances and resolutions or parts thereof insofar as they are inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed or rescinded.
