GOP's Ken Brandt seeks another term

Kenneth E. Brandt, Republican from the Falmouth, Conoy Township area, is actively seeking a third term as Representative to the Pennsylvania General Assembly this election. During his four years in office Mr. Brandt has, to his credit, established an impressive rapport with both the rural as well as the urban segments of his district.

Having lived and worked in a farming community, Brandt has long been aware of the needs and problems encountered by both small family farms and the larger farming cooperatives. Brandt, a member of the Agriculture Committee, sponsored legislation establishing a State Bargaining Board to determine the standards of farming cooperatives and their members.

Another area of prime concern deals with the financial difficulties encountered by the elderly living on fixed incomes and families with low incomes. Brandt strongly advocates legislation which will give tax relief to the elderly.

Problems pertaining to the more industrialized urban areas including the fair distribution of welfare monies and programs, the flood prevention act and revision of the school code are just a few of the legislative issues which Brandt feels

are in need of further study and revision.

Brandt has established a close working relationship with the local governments in his district often in an advisory capacity regarding the carrying out of new laws, the distribution of state money grants, etc.

Brandt, who serves on the Law and Justice Committee and the Agriculture Committee, has an impressive 98% voting record. He prides himself on his easy accessibility and several of his constituents attest to the fact that "he's around when you need him" whether it's a lost birth certificate, a bill collector harrasing a 90 year old widow for delinquent taxes, a welfare check that got lost in the mail, or a complaint that a tree fell down across a state road he gives all the attention that each case requires.

One of Brandt's most monumental achievements took place this year with the naming of the new

intercounty bridge. He notes that the naming of the Wright's Ferry Bridge was (in his opinion) more difficult than the actual construction of the bridge.

A native of the Village of Falmouth, Ken Brandt was graduated from Elizabethtown Area High School and soon after entered the family business of A.F. Brandt's Sons. He is married to the former Jean Marie Brandt and they are the parents of five children. An active community leader, Brandt served as both vice president and president of the Elizabethtown Jaycees and went on to serve for a time as National Jaycee Director. A member of the First Church of God (Elizabethtown), Brandt also served on the Elizabethtown Area School Board. Having become increasingly concerned with the problems in local government Brandt decided to take an active role in the area of lawmaking.

Self-Breast exam film at Norlanco

All women of childbearing age and beyond are invited to a film showing at Norlance Family Health Center, Monday, November 1, at 7:30 p.m.

The films, loaned by the American Cancer Society, are "Breast Self-Examination" and "For A Wonderful Life."

"Breast Self-Examination" describes this easily-learned technique, first as done by a doctor, then by the women performers. Following the film, a demonstration dummy will be available so that each person attending can try the technique under supervision.

"For A Wonderful Life" features a discussion of why the Pap Examination is necessary, shows how it is done, and what the laboratory results will indicate.

Both films are short, allowing time for an informal discussion period.

Babara Blouch, Physician's Assistant at Norlanco, will be on hand to answer any question that may arise from the films.
