The "Thompson Cycle Car'" uses a special mount which simplifies attaching and detaching the sidecar from the motorcycle. According to Mr. Zuch, his sidecar converts a bike into practical family machine "without compromising the feeling of independence and wind-in-the-face free dom that is what motor-
cycling is all about.'
