An unusually fine program of events is scheduled for St. Mark's United Methodist Church of Mount Joy, Pa., during the month of November, 1976.

On Sunday afternoon, November 14th, from 4 to 5 p.m. a representative of Geneva College will speak to prospective college students and their parents about the benefits and possibilities of a Christian college. At 7 p.m. an evening service will be given over to representatives of Teen Challenge who will share the excitement of the ministry to victims of drugs and alcohol.

A Harvest Home Celebration will follow on the next Sunday, November 21st, at the regular Worship Service at 10:15 a.m. Members of the congregation have been asked to provide articles for consumption by the people at Simpson House in Philadelphia, an institution of the United Methodist Church for the elderly.
