On November 12 all cubs will meet at Seiler School in Mount Joy at 6:30 to 9 p.m. for a Hayride and campfire. Parents can also attend.

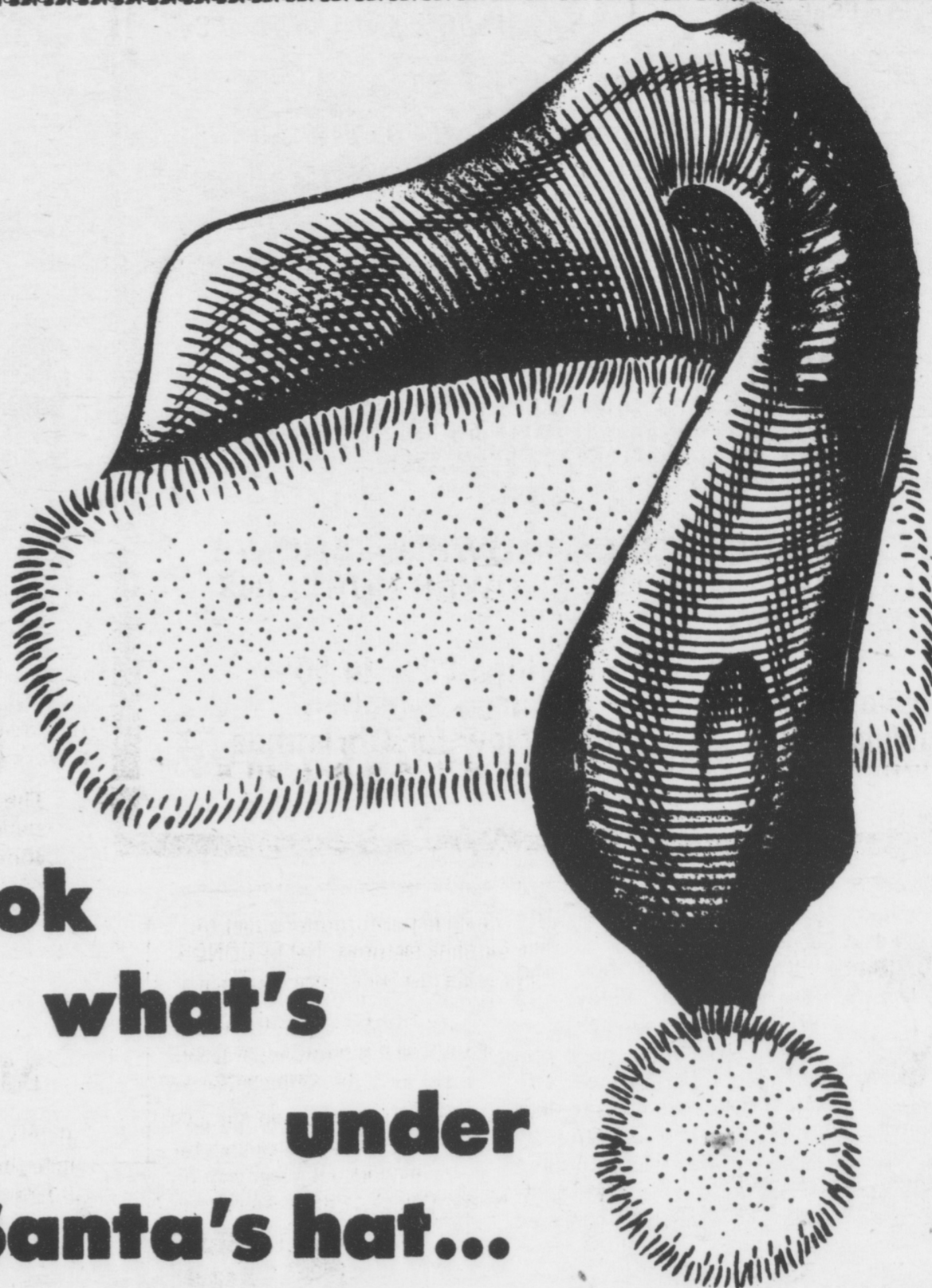
Jere Koser promoted

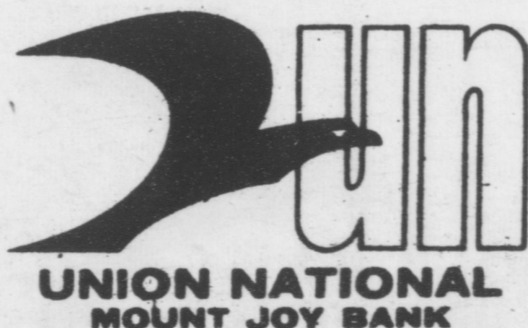
