

Bus route changes

Since the major route and schedule change which took place after Labor Day, the Red Rose Transit Authority has updated schedules on some routes to improve convenience and dependability.

On December 6, 1976, a new schedule is planned for Route 17—Mount Joy—Elizabethtown, which will increase service for the Landisville-Rohrerstown and Colebrook Apartments area.

These changes have been printed on white paper sheets, and are available on buses or at RRTA offices. Any bus schedule, or up-to-date information

about where or how the buses are running can be obtained by calling the RRTA telephone information line at 397-4246. Persons are on duty from 5 a.m. to 9 p.m., every weekday, and 5 a.m. to 5 p.m. on Saturday. If you have any doubts about your current bus service, please call.

Mount Joy—Elizabethtown—first trip will cover Colebrook Apts. inbound to Lancaster only, not outbound to Mount Joy.

Route is revised in Mount Joy; Main Street, to Donegal Springs Road, to Angle Street, to Main Street, to Lancaster.
