Dr. Mark Ebersole is elected new president of E-town College

Dr. Mark C. Ebersole was elected the 11th President of Elizabethtown College Saturday during a special meeting of the Board of Trustees on the campus.

Now Dean of the Graduate School and Associate Vice President for Academic Affairs at Temple University, Dr. Ebersole will assume his duties at Elizabethtown July 1.

Dr. Ebersole, 55, will succeed Dr. Morley J. Mays, who will leave office June 30, having reached the College's mandatory age of retirement. President Mays assumed his duties October 1, 1966.

Dr. Ebersole holds degrees from Elizabethtown College (B.S., 1943), Crozer Theological Seminary (B.D., 1946), the University of Pennsylvania (M.A., 1948), and Columbia University (Ph. D., 1952). He was granted an honorary Doctor of Laws degree by Elizabethtown in 1969.

He has been associated with Elmira College, Bucknell University, the Ford Foundation and Temple University in his distinguished teaching career.

As President-elect at Elizabethtown, he follows

in the footsteps of his father-in-law, the late Dr. A.C. Baugher, who was President of the College from 1941 to 1961, when he retired.

He is married to the former Dorothy Baugher and currently resides in Princeton, N.J. The Ebersoles have two children. Son Philip is majoring in history at Trinity College, Hartford, Conn. Son Stephen is majoring in business at Indiana University, Bloomington, Ind.

Dr. Ebersole is the son of the late Mr. and Mrs. B.W.S. Ebersole, Hershey.
