PUBLIC NOTICE DONEGAL SCHOOL DISTRICT Lancaster County, PA RESOLUTION

RESOLUTION DECREASING THE COMPENSATION OF THE TAX COLLECTORS, FOR THE COLLECTION OF THE REAL ESTATE SCHOOL TAXES, FROM TWO PERCENT TO ONE PERCENT.

WHEREAS it is necessary to realize as much money as possible out of the already-existing tax structure at the current tax rates; and

WHEREAS the Board of Directors of Donegal School District wish to continue to provide the best possible education at the lowest possible taxes to the taxpayers of Donegal School District; and

WHEREAS all revenues should be used by the School District to the fullest extent possible; and

WHEREAS 72 Purdons Statutes §5511.35 vests the power in the Board of Directors of School Districts to determine the compensation of the tax collectors for the collection of School District taxes;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Directors of Donegal School District, Lancaster County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby resolved by the authority of the same as follows:

SECTION 1. The compensation to be paid by the Donegal School District to the Tax Collectors for the collection of the real estate taxes levied by Donegal School District shall be reduced from two percent (2%) to one percent (1%) of all such taxes collected.

SECTION 2. All resolutions or parts of resolutions in accord with this resolution are hereby repealed insofar as they conflict herewith.

SECTION 3. This resolution shall be effective and shall govern the compensation paid to all tax collectors who are elected or re-elected in the municipal election of 1977. The compensation of the tax collectors who are elected or re-elected in the municipal election of 1977 shall be one percent (1%) of all real estate taxes collected by the newly-elected or re-elected tax collectors, after said tax collectors have been sworn into office.
