**Four more days in school year**

Donegal School directors extended the school calendar four days on Thursday night. The last day of school for students is now Monday, June 13. School was originally slated to end June 7, but two makeup days were added because of the strike in October, and two more days because of snow closings.

The board also approved lowering the commission on tax collections from the present two per cent to one per cent. The district estimates saving approximately

\$28,000.00 on it's annual \$43,000.000 tax collection bill.

The directors agreed to allow the Mount Gretna Snowmobile Volunteers to restore the former radar station at Governor Dick park for a headquarters. The property had been given to the school district.

The board also learned that Donegal had been chosen as an alternate district in the state's planned "Project 81"—a five year program develop competency education in 12

pilot school systems, including the School District of Lancaster. Linda Boozer was named liaison for Project 81 activities in the Donegal District.

The board gave permission to advertise this spring to applicants for District Census Taker. Names should be submitted to the district Office by February 11, 1977. Compensation is 15c a name and 12c a mile the same as last year.

The district added 1194 new names in 1976 census. There are now 12,796 names.
