Lip-reading course

A course in lipreading will be offered soon by The Hearing Conservation Center. Lipreading skills may be used by any person with any degree of hearing loss, whether they use a hearing aid or not, to improve their understanding of conversation. For many people, a aid users, as well as non-hearing aid users, often benefit from this training.

The 6 session course will begin Monday, February 21, 1977 at The Hearing Conservation Center in Lancaster. Class time is 6:30 p.m. until 8:00 p.m. hearing loss makes normal conversation sound 'mumbled' or 'hard to understand' rather than too soft or too quiet. Training in lipreading helps these persons use their hearing and visual clues to make conversation easier and more clearly understood. Hearing
