The Crew will be holding a sub sale on Friday, March 25. Orders can be turned in to the office by March 21.

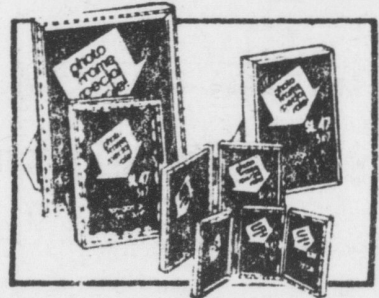

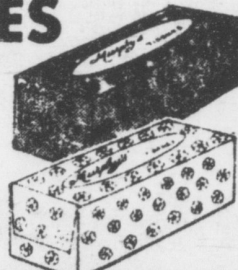

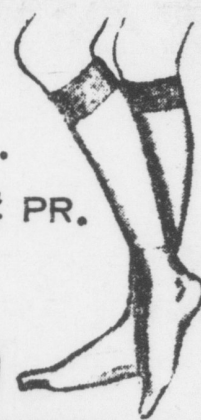
