[continued from page 7] tax, as well as property tax and rent rebate.

Those who qualify for rent or property tax rebate must have a total household income of not more than \$7,500 and must meet one of the following tests:

65 or over, widow or widower over 50, permanently disabled. All must have an income of less than \$7,500.

The forms for these are obtainable at the Columbia multipurpose center.
