

# Endslows donate land to E. Donegal

Members of the East Donegal Township Supervisors signed the agreement between Mr. and Mrs. William Endslow and themselves. The Endslows will donate eight acres and 357 perch to the Township to complete phase I of the

planned residential development known as Country Village.

The sub-division plan adjoins the existing park. The supervisors approved the Park Commission's recommendation to advertise for bids for a 38 X 50 foot pavilion to be erected on

the park grounds. Specifications were submitted by Dan Gohn Associates and will be advertised immediately in hopes of receiving early bids.

Charles Johns, fire chief, reported three fire calls, one false alarm, and one

chimney fire in March. "No parking" lines will be repainted at the Health center and on the north side of the square. Paint will be supplied to members of the Civic Association, who volunteered to paint the square's fence and pump.
