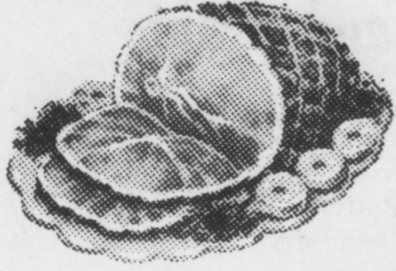

The Mount Joy Recreation Association held its monthly meeting at the Mount Joy boro hall.

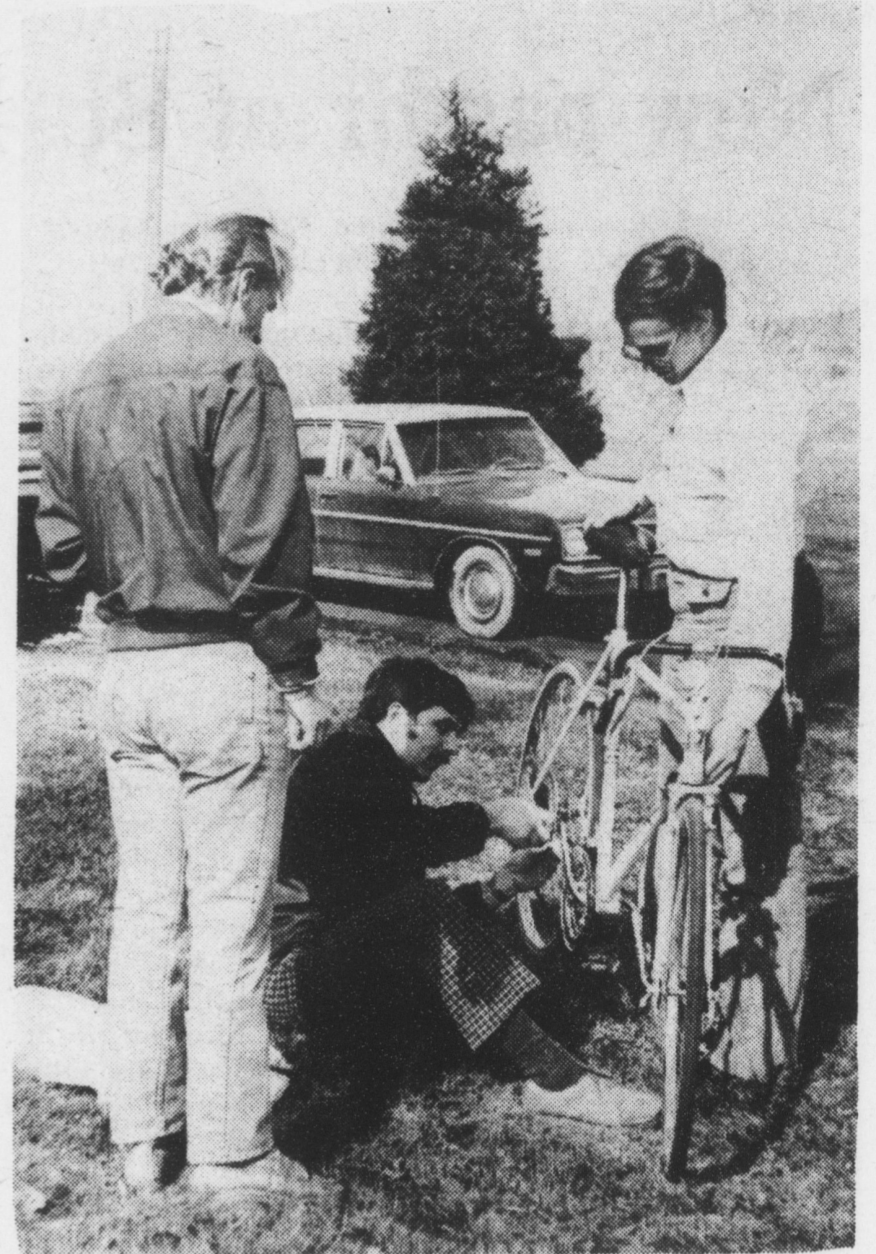

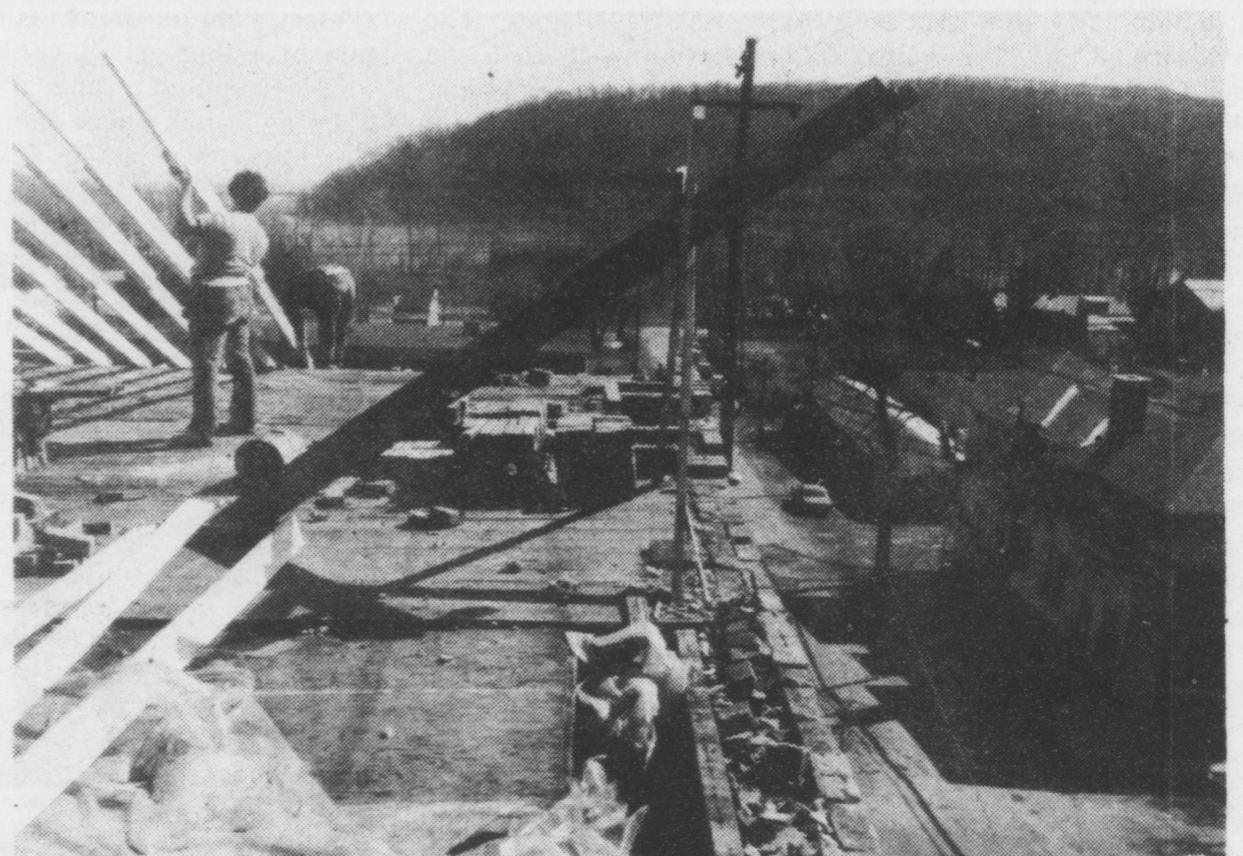
