CHARLES HAY SLOAD

Charles Hay Sload, 82, a retired blacksmith, died Sunday at 10 a.m., at Fairview Manor Nursing Home, Columbia, after a lengthy illness.

He was the husband of the late Mildred Smith Sload who died in 1975. His first wife, Esther Flowers Sload, died in 1931. Sload is a former resident of Maytown.

Before his retirement, Sload worked as a traveling blacksmith in the Ronks area.

He served during World War I as a blacksmith in the 3rd field artillery in France.

A member of United Church of Christ, Maytown he also belonged to Reese Hall Veterans of Foreign Wars 8757, Mountville.

Born in Maytown, he was the son of the late Warren and Sara Roath Sload.

Movie at First United Methodist

To Russia With Love, a film, will be shown at the First United Methodist Church, 216 E. Market Street, Marietta, at 7 p.m., on Sunday, April 17.

This gripping motion picture speaks to the heart. Many of the shots were filmed inside Russia and give eloquent testimony to the fact that hunger for the Word of God is very real in that land of closed churches. It graphically portrays life today for many thousands of Christians in the Communist world.

Secret arrangements were made in advance for an English-speaking Russian Christian to rendezvous with a US photographer on a visit to Russia. The two met quietly at an appointed hour, and for the next few weeks the cameraman captured a revealing glimpse of the underworld church at worship. He found himself deeply moved by what he saw, which is faithfully recorded in **To Russia with Love**.

"This film was one of the most difficult projects we've ever undertaken," declares L. Joe Bass, Founder-President of "Underground Evangelism." "We sent a professional photographer with minimum equipment into Russia to obtain the necessary shots, for the sight of much professional camera equipment would be enough to put KGB on a foreign photographer's trail 24 hours a day. Our man was able to lose himself among the vast crowd of tourists in Moscow and go on his way unchallenged and unmolested. The result was some of the finest behind-the-scenes shots we have ever seen."

An actual border crossing, which helps portray Underground Evangelism's wide-scale, Bible-smuggling ministry, is also seen. During the first part of the film, the voice of Stefan Bankov, a young Christian lay pastor (whose escape to the West with his wife and two children is dramatized in the film), is heard speaking in Bulgarian, while a narrator over-dubs in English.

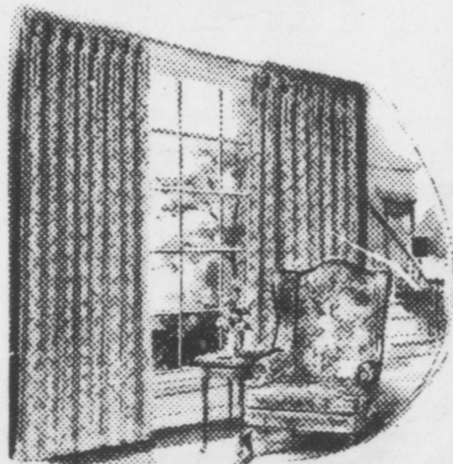
