The Donegal High School Guidance Office has announced the following testing information.

The National Educational Development Tests (NEDT) were administered to all tenth grade students earlier in the year. The guidance counselors will be interpreting the results of those tests when they meet with the group on Friday, May 13, 1st period in the auditorium. Parents are cordially invited to be present.

The NEDT battery includes tests of educational development in five basic areas: English Usage, Mathematics Usage, Social Studies Reading, Natural Science Reading, and Word Usage. It is administered nationally to hundreds of thousands of ninth and tenth grade students and its scores are reported in a standardized manner so each student can see where he stands among others at the same grade level throughout the United States.

The NEDT offers an impersonal, comprehensive estimate of the student's educational development, providing an important tool for present appraisal and future planning. Among the most important information they will need for constructive planning is an accurate assessment of their abilities.
