 Gay Street to Armstrong—May 26th.

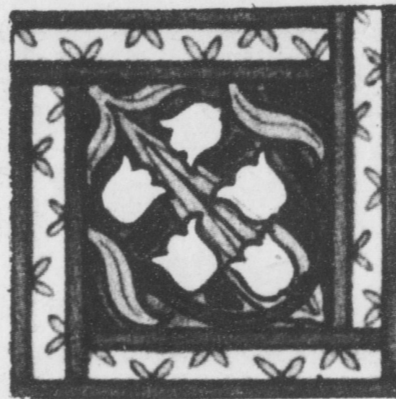

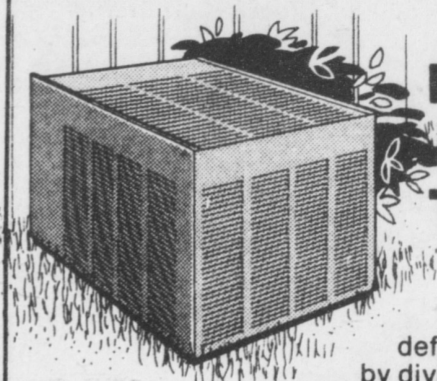
