Albright and Steinhart considered for Merit Scholarships

Two Donegal High School students (Karen Albright and Eric Steinhart), received scores on their PSAT/NMSQT test that place them in the top five percent of over one million students tested in 1976. They are among some 49,000 students being considered for recognition in the 1978 Merit Program. Next fall the school will be notified whether these Donegal students qualify as a semi-finalist or commendation students.
Karen is the daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Marvin Albright, R.D. #1, Marietta, Pa. Eric is the son of Mr. and Mrs. Dean Steinhart, R.D. #2, Mount Joy, Pa. They are both members of the junior class.

The PSAT, Preliminary Scholastic Aptitude Test, is given to high school students throughout the United States and other countries. Verbal and mathematical reasoning abilities are measured by the test. Not only does it provide an impartial assessment of the ability to do college work, but it is a "trial run" for the SAT required by many colleges for admission. All who take the test have the opportunity to enter the two scholarship competitions administered by the National Merit Scholarship Corporation.
