Regional planning course at Middletown

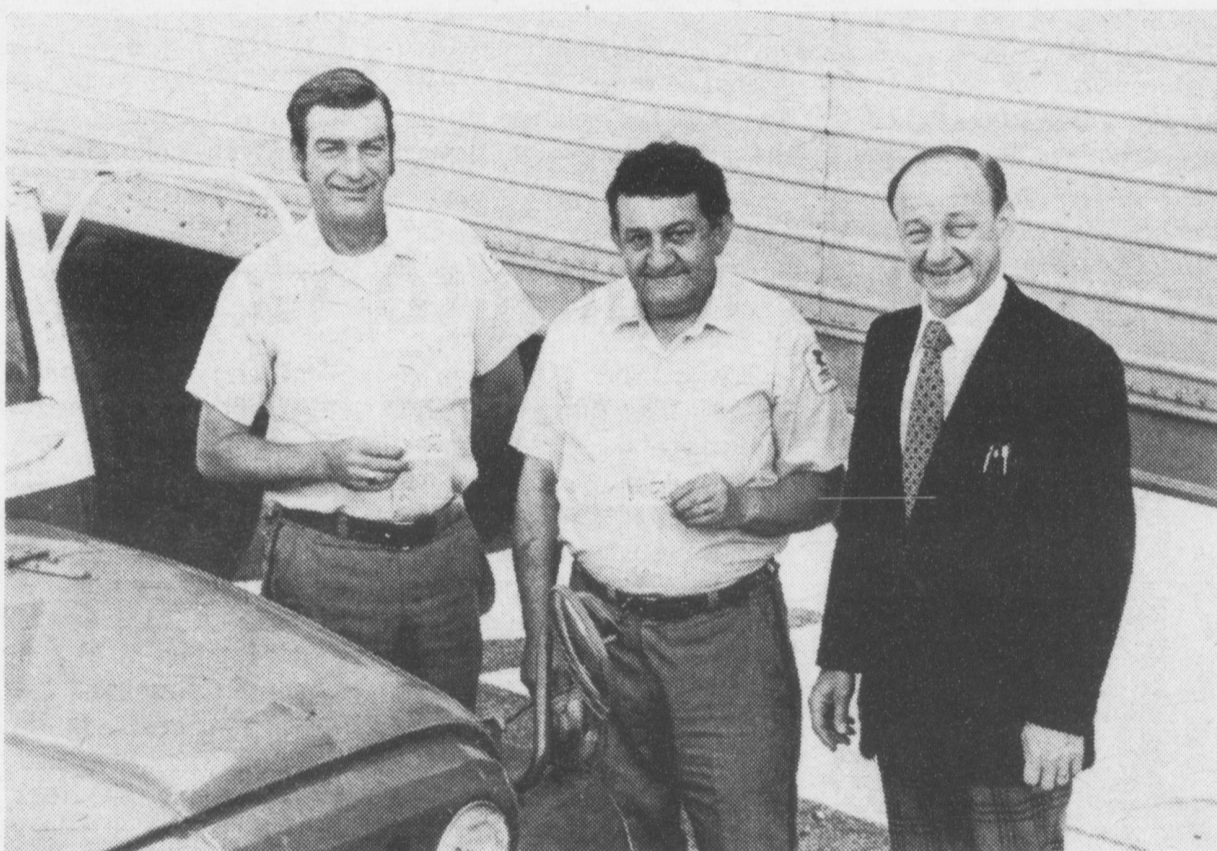
