Other budget items included extra curricular \$61,550; community services, \$3,350; capital outlay, \$30,350; debt service, \$312,200; and inter-system payments, \$217,578.

The budget reserve stands at \$40,000.

The board announced that it has applied for a \$250,000 loan for capital improvements, scheduled to be repaid in five years.

The funds will be used to replace the heating system in the Wilbur I. Beahm Junior High School and to repair the roof on the high school that is over the main classroom section.

The board has sent word to the state requesting that a section of Route 441, in front of Riverview Elementary School, be made a no-passing zone.

Last April a school bus was struck by a car and the board expressed concern over the current traffic conditions.

Commencement exercises will be June 13, at 6:30 p.m. on the high school football field. The baccalaureate service will be held June 12 at 7:45 p.m. in the high school. The Rev. Theodore Schneider, pastor of Good Shepherd Lutheran Church, Lancaster, will be the speaker.


