

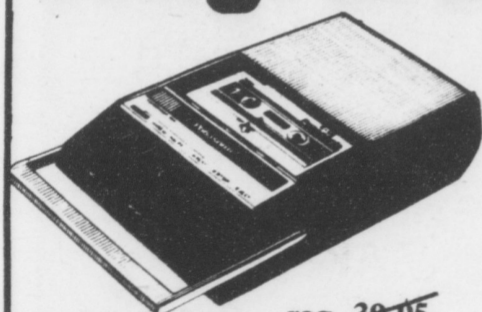
urance Counselor designation in 1976.
