The bear is believed to be the largest ever taken in that area of Canada. It was estimated to be about 20 years old.

This was the first Quebec hunting trip for Mike. He was on a week-long camping trip with Nathan

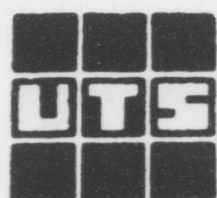
