River Commission to hold hearing in Camp Hill

Notice is hereby given that the Susquehanna River Basin Commission will have a public hearing as part of its review of the Mount Joy Borough Authority's (Mount Joy, Pa.) ground-water development. The hearing will be held immediatly following the Commission's July 14, 1977, meeting which is scheduled to begin at 1:00 p.m. in the Penn Harris Motor Inn, U.S. Routes 11 & 15, in Camp Hill, Penn-

sylvania. The hearing is being held to receive pertinent testimony from the Authority and interested parties concerning the Authority's development and its potential impact on the water and related resources of the basin.

The Mount Joy Borough Authority water supply system serves approximately 5,600 persons within, the Borough and parts of East Donegal, Rapho and Mount Joy Townships, Lancaster

County, Pennsylvania. The Authority anticipates withdrawing 1.6 million gallons per day (MGD) from two wells and developing appropriate system facilities for the wells.

The wells are located about two miles west of Mount Joy and have a combined safe yield of 1.6 MGD water softening plant, transmission facilities and a 1.0 MGD steel standpipe.


The principal areas of

interest upon which the Commission is basing its review of the project are:

1) demand projections; 2) capability to satisfy the Commission's requirements regarding consumptive uses of water; 3) availability of water; and 4) utilization of water.

The application documents filed by the project sponsor are available for public inspection during regular business hours at the office of the Susquehanna River Basin Commission, 5012 Lenker Street, Mechanicsburg, Pennsylvania 17055. The offices are open to the public from 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m., Monday through Friday.

Persons wishing to participate in the hearing may present oral and/or written testimony. Those wishing to testify in person are requested to contact the Secretary of the Commission, in writing, prior to the hearing.
