One hundred outstanding junior class students are selected from various schools each year for the five-day program of in-

struction and recreation. The main objective of this public service program is to prepare the students for leadership roles in their respective communities upon graduation from high school.

3. Receive a report from the Public Safety Committee on the guidelines necessary to prohibit right turns at traffic lights.


4. Receive the recommendations of the Parks and Recreation Committee
