The Rev. Glen B. Keidel, Sr., pastor of St. James Evangelical Lutheran Church, Columbia, died Tuesday at 3 p.m. at Columbia Hospital after an illness of several months.

The Rev. Keidel was 58 and lived at 17 W. High St., Maytown. He was the

husband of Pearl Wilson Keidel.

Pastor of St. James since September 1971, the minister was a member of the Columbia Ministerial Association, and a graduate of Gettysburg College and Lutheran Theological Seminary Gettysburg.

Born in Confluence,

Somerset County, he was a son of the late Henry and Mabel Boyer Keidel.

Beside his widow, he is survived by a son, the Rev. Glen B. Keidel, Jr., Dorsife; Northumberland County; two grandchildren, and one brother, Paul G. Keidel, Washington.

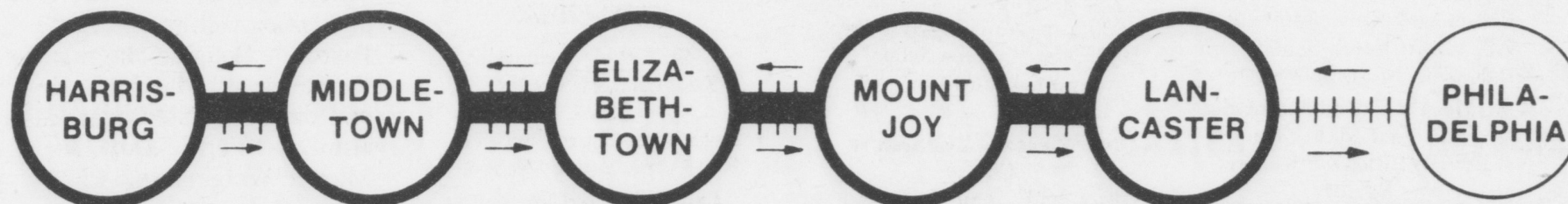
