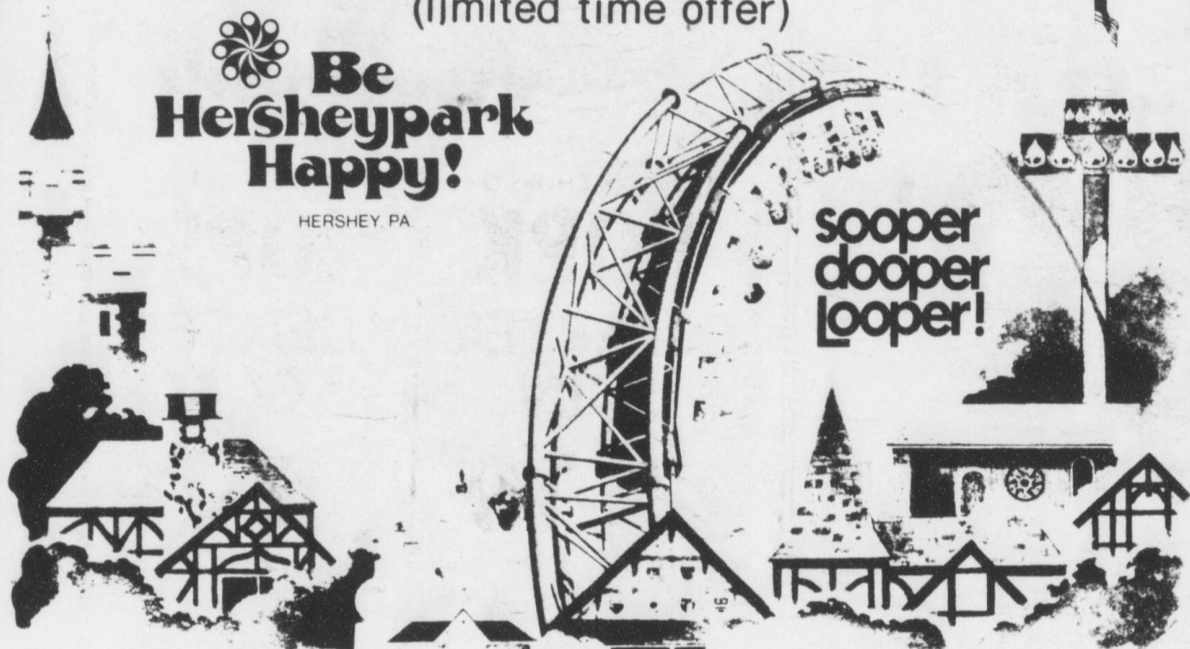

Cynthia Fore gets master's

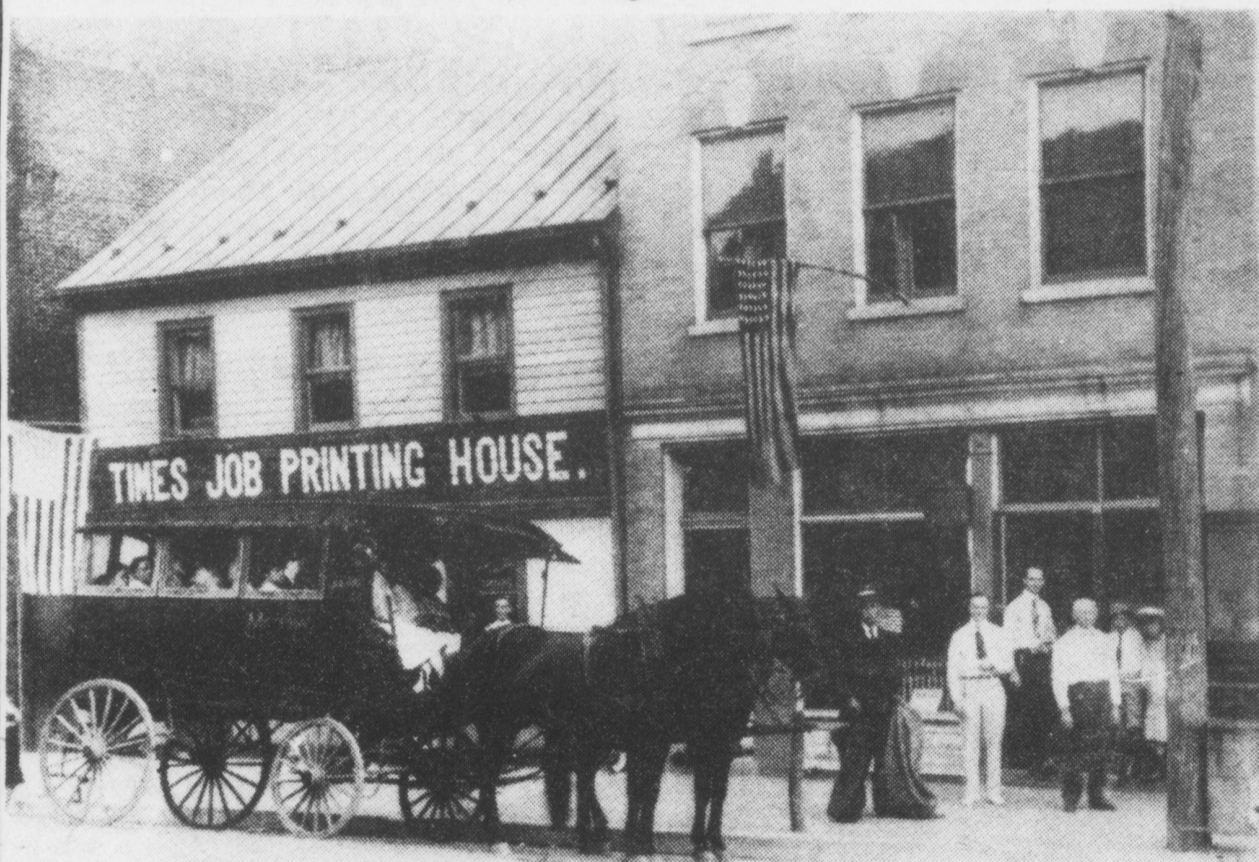
