### Tim Eshleman makes dean's list

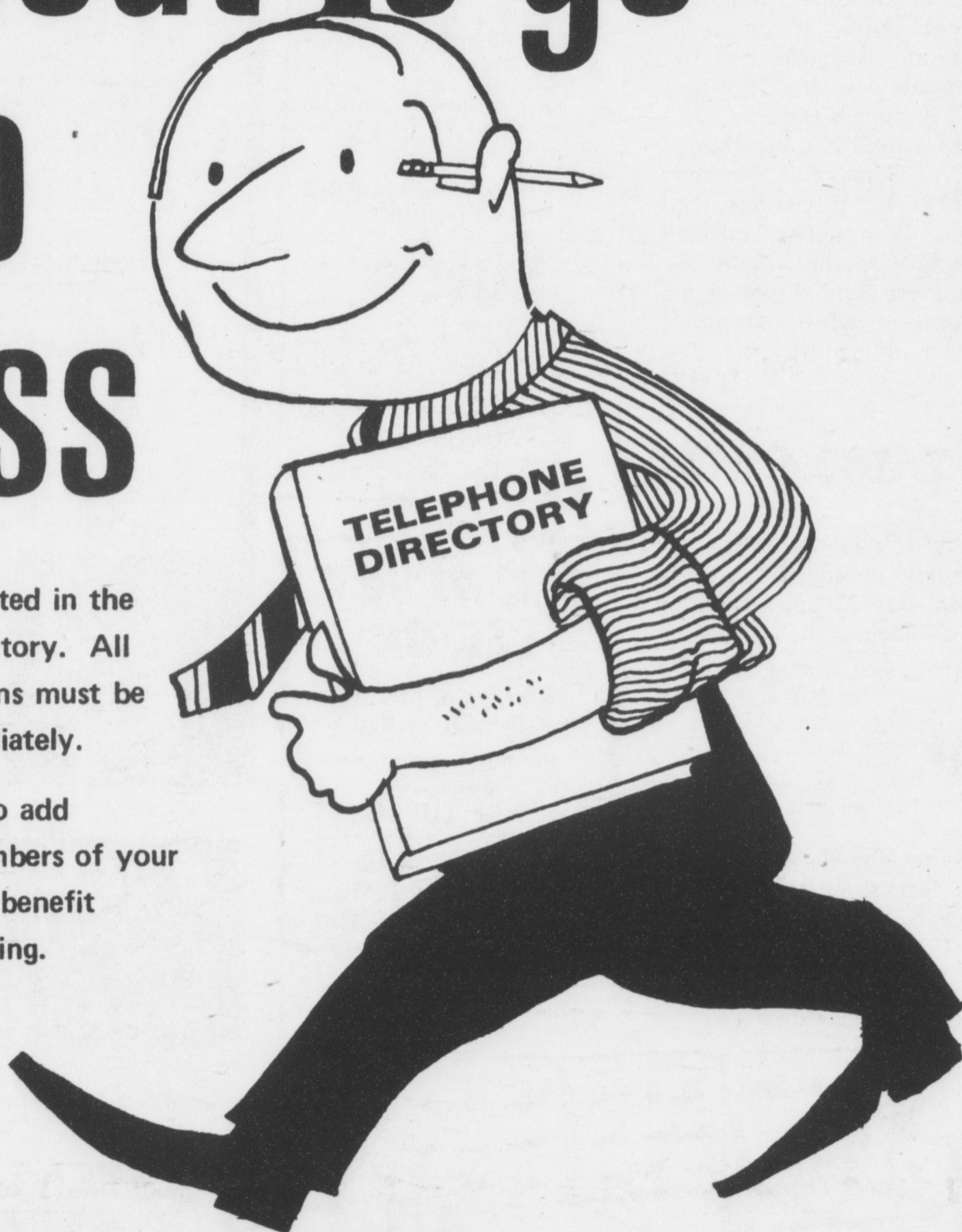
Timothy Eshelman of Mount Joy has been named to the dean's list at Juniata College for the recently completed spring term.

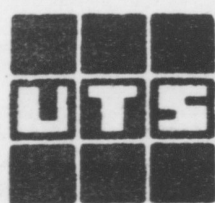
