One of the world's greatest pianists will give a free concert on Sunday, July 3 at the Long Park amphitheater in Lancaster, Pa.

Pianist Andre Watts will be the soloist with the Lancaster Symphony Orchestra for an outdoor concert at 8 p.m.

Internationally acclaimed as one of the most talented pianists in the world today and one of the highest paid, Watts is donating his talents for the concert which is sponsored by the Lancaster Summer Arts Festival.
