Marietta Boro Council meeting

Members of Marietta Boro Council unanimously moved to compile ordinances for traffic control devices within Marietta Boro at a special council

meeting Thursday night. The ordinances will comply with Pennsylvania Motor Vehicle Code.

Ordinance to be known as "77-9" would regulate

traffic on one way streets. Violators would be prosecuted. Included are these streets: N. Waterford; N. New Haven; W. Walnut; Mulberry; Burgess; Aaron and Elk Avenue.
