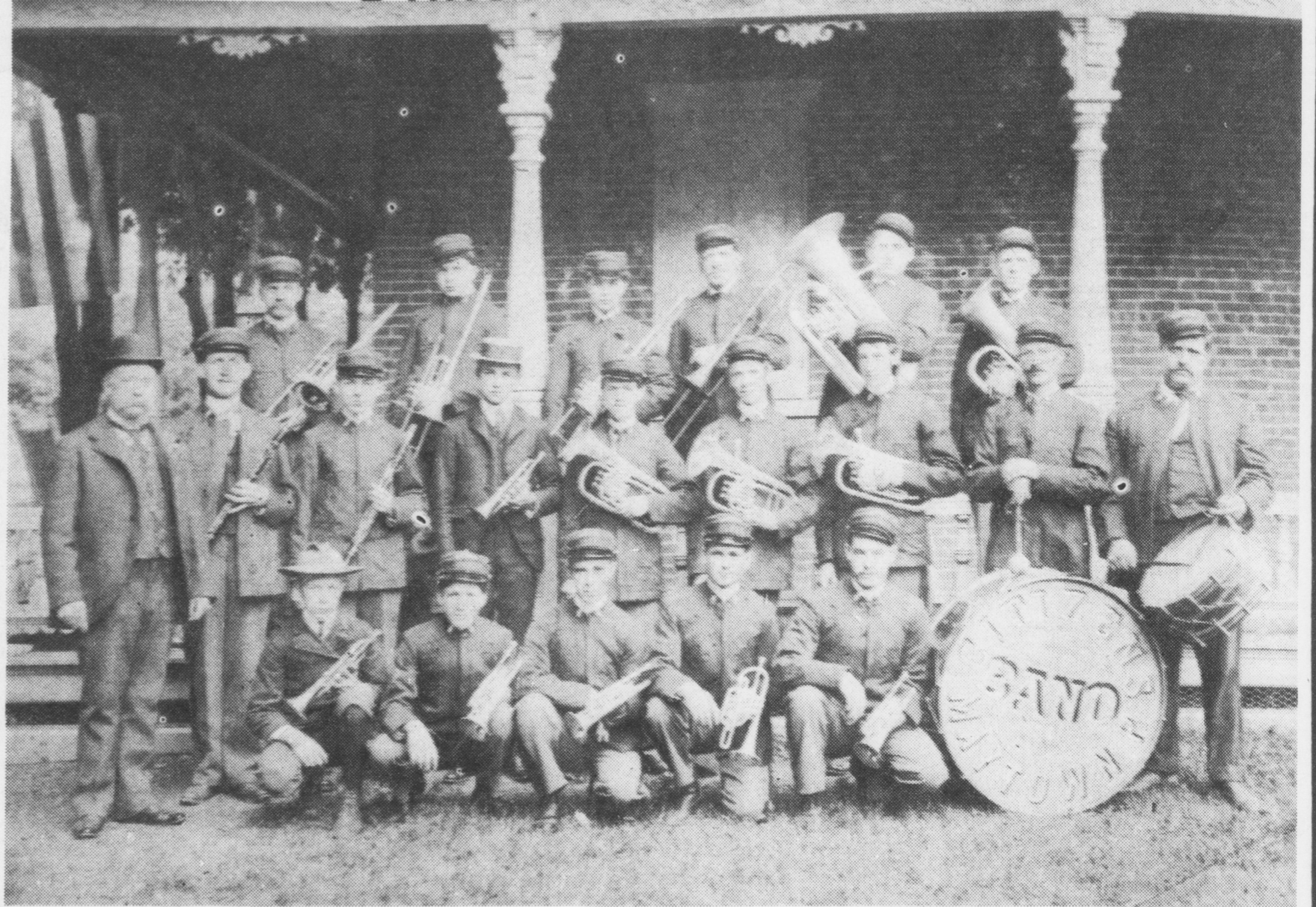

Be a TAP volunteer

If you feel a desire to help others, you might consider becoming a TAP volunteer.

TAP stands for "Telephone Assurance Program," and it's designed to help older citizens. If you are a TAP volunteer, you spend about five hours a week on the phone, calling homebound people aged 60 or over. The purpose is two-fold: The calls first of all ease the

loneliness felt by many senior citizens, and secondly, your calls serve to check up on people who may get visitors very seldom.

The Office of Aging, which administers the TAP program, says that the main qualifications for a volunteer are commitment, concern, and sensitivity. If you would like to give it a try, call 299-2547, or write to 50 So. Duke St., Lancaster, PA, 17602.

Celebration block party

The residents in the neighborhood of the Donegal Springs Road Park, Mount Joy, will hold a block party on Saturday, July 16 beginning at 3:00 p.m. The party will be a celebration in honor of the success of the "Save Our Park" campaign.

The "S. O. P." campaign was a bid by the area residents to prevent the re-zoning of the park from "open space-park" to "residential".

Borough Council at a recent meeting voted not to re-zone the Donegal Springs Road park.

The neighbors are invited to bring their own food, chairs and place settings to the park on Saturday, July 16. Grills will be available for cooking and there will be games and prizes. All residents and guests of the first block of Donegal Springs Road and West Donegal Street are invited to attend.

New bike laws

Marietta police intend to enforce traffic laws for bicycles—strictly.

From now on, they will prosecute for auto-type offenses like running a stop sign, riding on the left side of a road, or reckless driving. Riding on sidewalks is also prohibited.

These changes are part of the new State motor

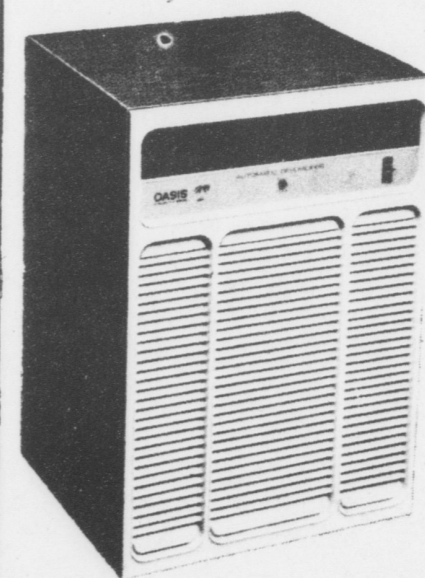
code.
