Hints for the elderly

Senior citizens will receive special consideration in the Emergency Fuel Program that is being started by the federal government. The program will prevent people's fuel from being shut off if they can't pay their bills (PP&L has its own program to prevent fuel cut-offs) and to help anyone suffering "dire need" because of high fuel costs.

To be eligible for the federal money, you must

Need financial help, a new apartment, or something to do in your spare time? The new "Resources for the Elderly" booklet published by the Office of Aging may give you hints on getting assistance. It gives a brief description of each program available as well as the phone number. The last sections of the

present evidence that your fuel bills were high between Oct. 1. 1976 and June 30, 1977. You must also have a low income (below \$3,648 for 2 people, or below \$3000 for one person), but ownership of a home or other assets doesn't disqualify you.
