 ORDINANCE NO 391**  
 AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF MOUNT JOY APPOINTING AN INDEPENDENT AUDITOR FOR THE PURPOSE OF MAKING AN INDEPENDENT EXAMINATION OF THE AUDITING RECORDS OF THE BOROUGH AND ABOLISHING THE OFFICE OF ELECTED BOROUGH AUDITOR.

WHEREAS, the Borough Council of the Borough of Mount Joy has determined that it is in the Borough's best interests to have a certified public accountant examine the financial records of the Borough; and

WHEREAS, the Borough Code authorizes the Borough Council to appoint an independent auditor and authorizes the Borough Council to abolish the office of elected auditor.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Borough Council of the Borough of Mount Joy as follows:

**Section 1.** Borough Council shall, by resolution, appoint an independent auditor every two years on the even numbered years. The auditor shall make an independent examination of the accounting records of the Borough for each fiscal year and perform all other duties and exercise all other powers as authorized by the Borough Code, Act of February 1, 1966, P.L. (1965).....No. 581.

**Section 2.** The office of elected Borough auditor is hereby abolished.

**Section 3.** This ordinance shall become effective immediately.

ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Borough Council of the Borough of Mount Joy this 12th day of September, 1977.
