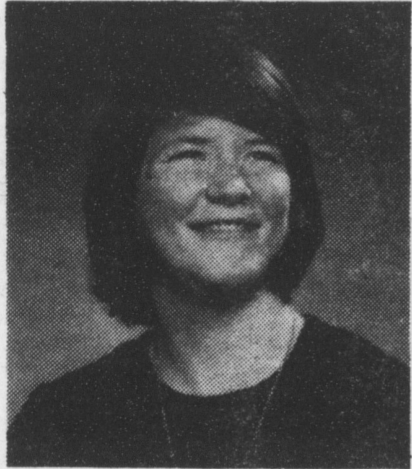


Rusella Markley to wed Eugene R. Hess

A March 25, 1978 wedding is planned.

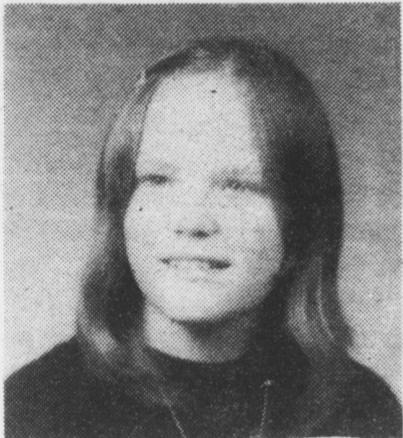


Cable TV employees honored

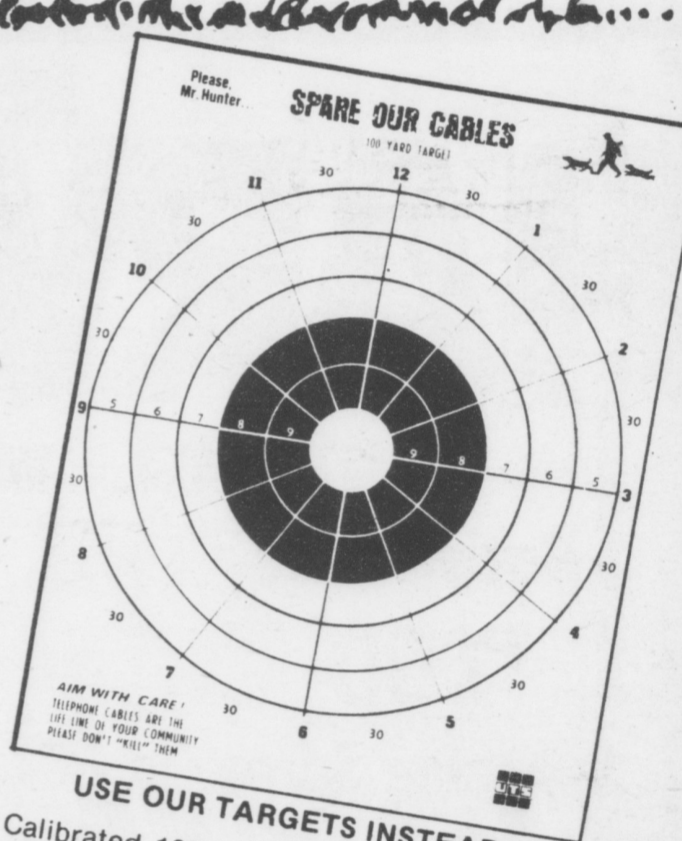

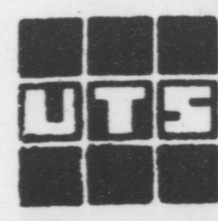

IT'S THE LAW!

PENNSYLVANIA CRIME CODE SECTION 3304 Malicious injury to telegraph, telephone, radio or television lines. b. Grading.—Criminal mischief is a felony of the third degree if the actor intentionally causes pecuniary loss in excess of \$5,000, or a substantial interruption or impairment of public communication, transportation, supply of water, gas or power, or other public service. It is a misdemeanor of the second degree if the actor intentionally causes pecuniary loss in excess of \$1,000, or a misdemeanor of the third degree if he intentionally or recklessly causes pecuniary loss in excess of \$500. Otherwise criminal mischief is a summary offense.
