Earl H. Kurtz, who has guided the financial affairs of Elizabethtown College for 20 years, will retire as treasurer on June 1, 1978.

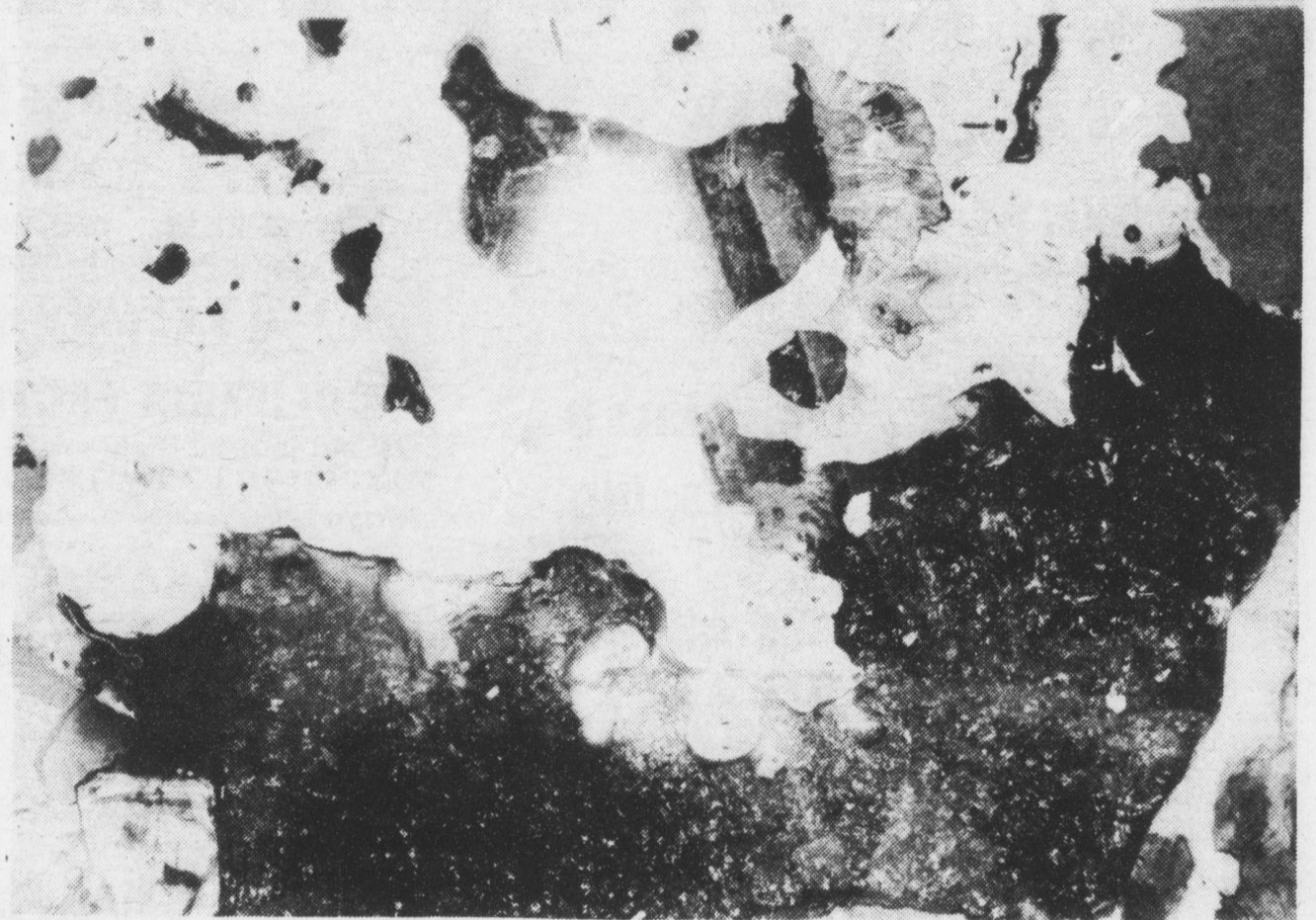
Announcing the retirement, President Ebersole said Kurtz has given "long, loyal, faithful, effective service" to the institution under four presidents.

Kurtz presided over the expansion of the campus from 60 acres to 110 and the construction of eight buildings, major additions

to five others, and complete renovation of several more. The value of the College's physical plant, for which he exercises major administrative responsibility, now is worth 10 times what it was in 1957.

He holds a B.S. degree from Elizabethtown College, Class of 1935, and a M.A. from New York University and completed further graduate work at the Wharton School of Business and at Temple University.

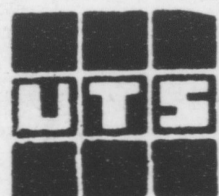
