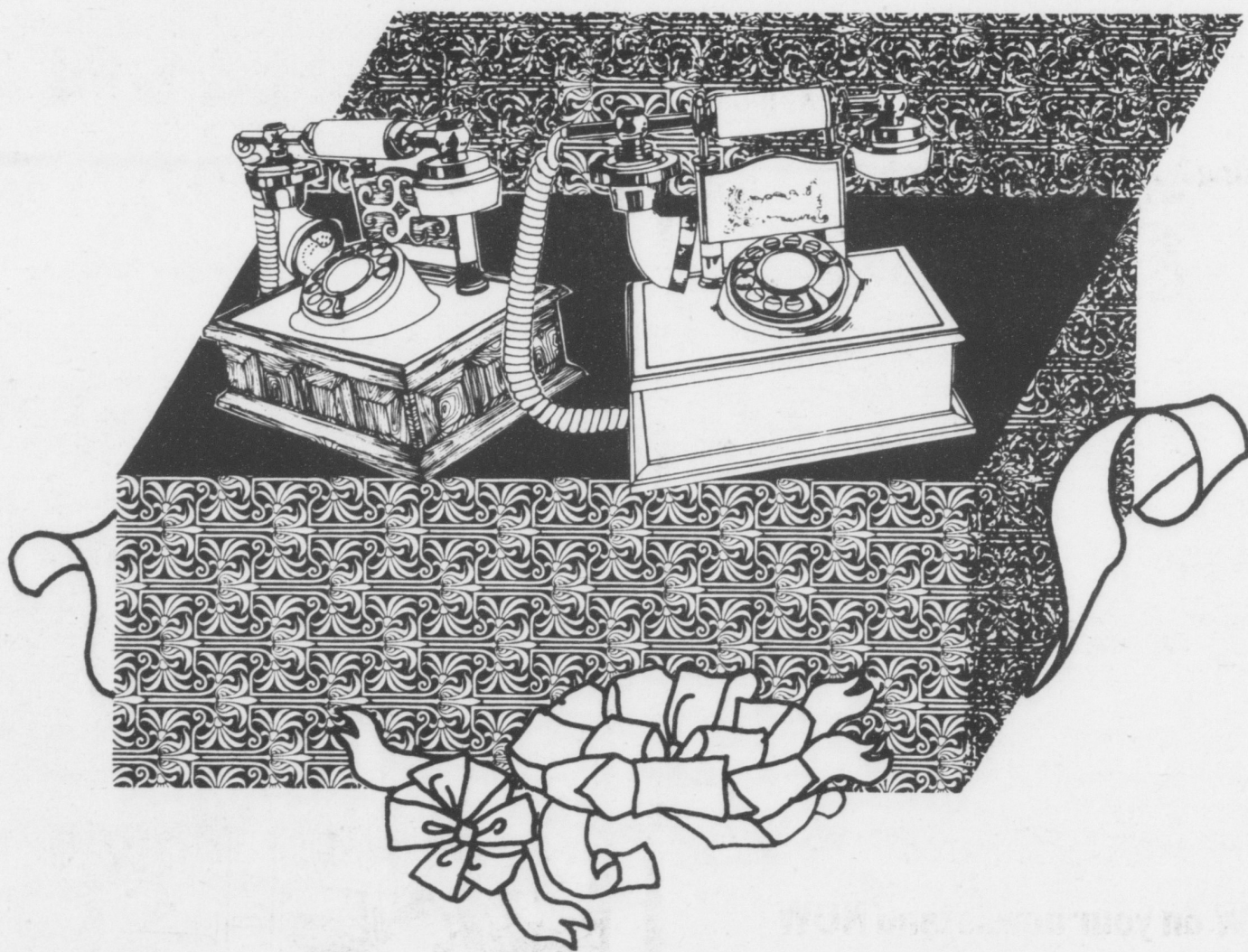
The Western District Roundtable is on Tuesday, December 6th, at 7:30 in the Glossbrenner United Methodist Church in Florin.

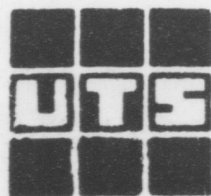

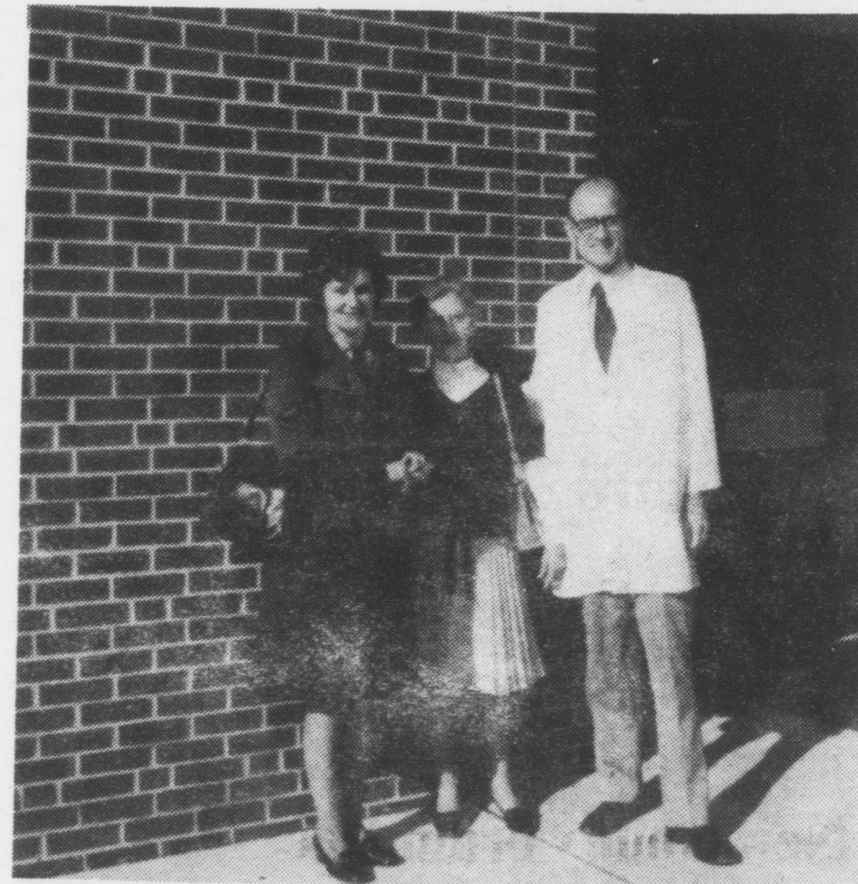
