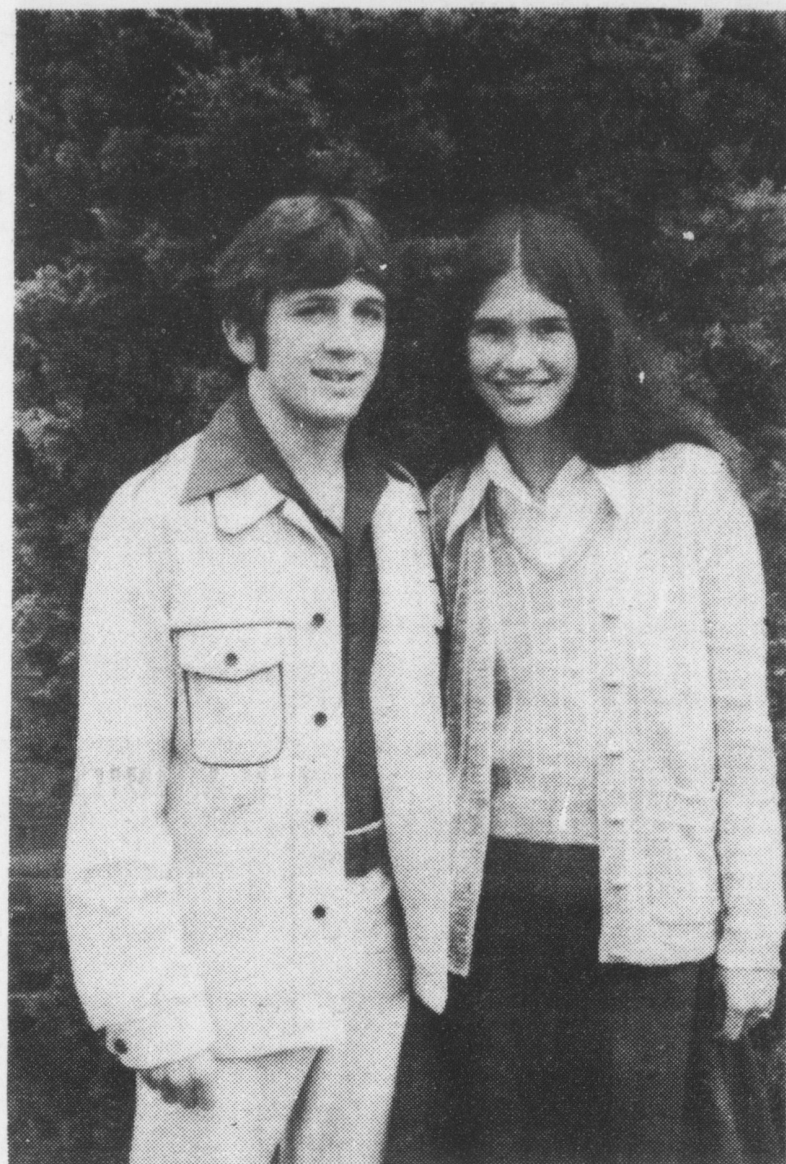
Xmas lunch

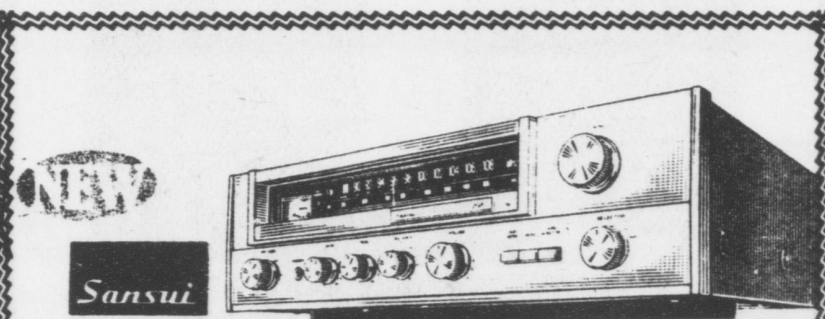
