Each 10th grader will at that time get a booklet containing his or her scores plus an explanation of how the scores can be used to "take a closer look at their school work and make plans for the future."

Other tests given this year include the ASVAB (Armed Services Vocational Aptitude Battery), the PSAT/NMSGT, and the SAT, also known as the "college boards." The SAT's were taken by 91 area seniors who need the test to get into college.
