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
Mystery Photo winner Carolyn LeFever got the most correct answers

Here are the questions we asked, and Carolyn's answers:




1. Q. — What is it? A. — "Bunches of flowers, wrapped in tissue paper, in buckets, sold on street corners." Correct!

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2. Q. — What is it and when did it fly here? A. -"Santa Claus' beard -Dec. 2, 1977, Fri. nite." Yes, yes, yes!




3. Q. — What is she looking at, and where is she? A. -- "Looking at a basketball hoop, at the Donegal High School." **Correct!**

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
