Here are the questions we asked, and Carolyn's answers:



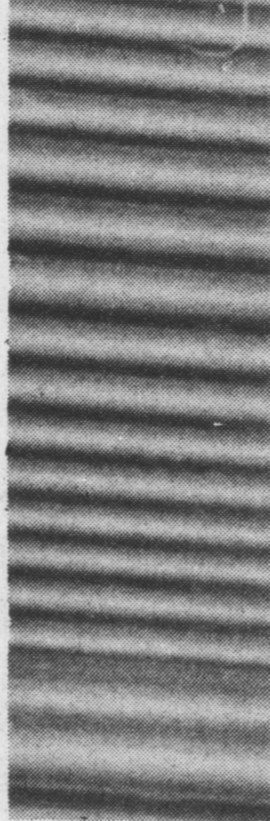
1. Q. — What is it? A. — "Bunches of flowers, wrapped in tissue paper, in buckets, sold on street corners." **Correct!**
