Are you tired of icy roads, blizzard conditions, school delays? Then think spring!

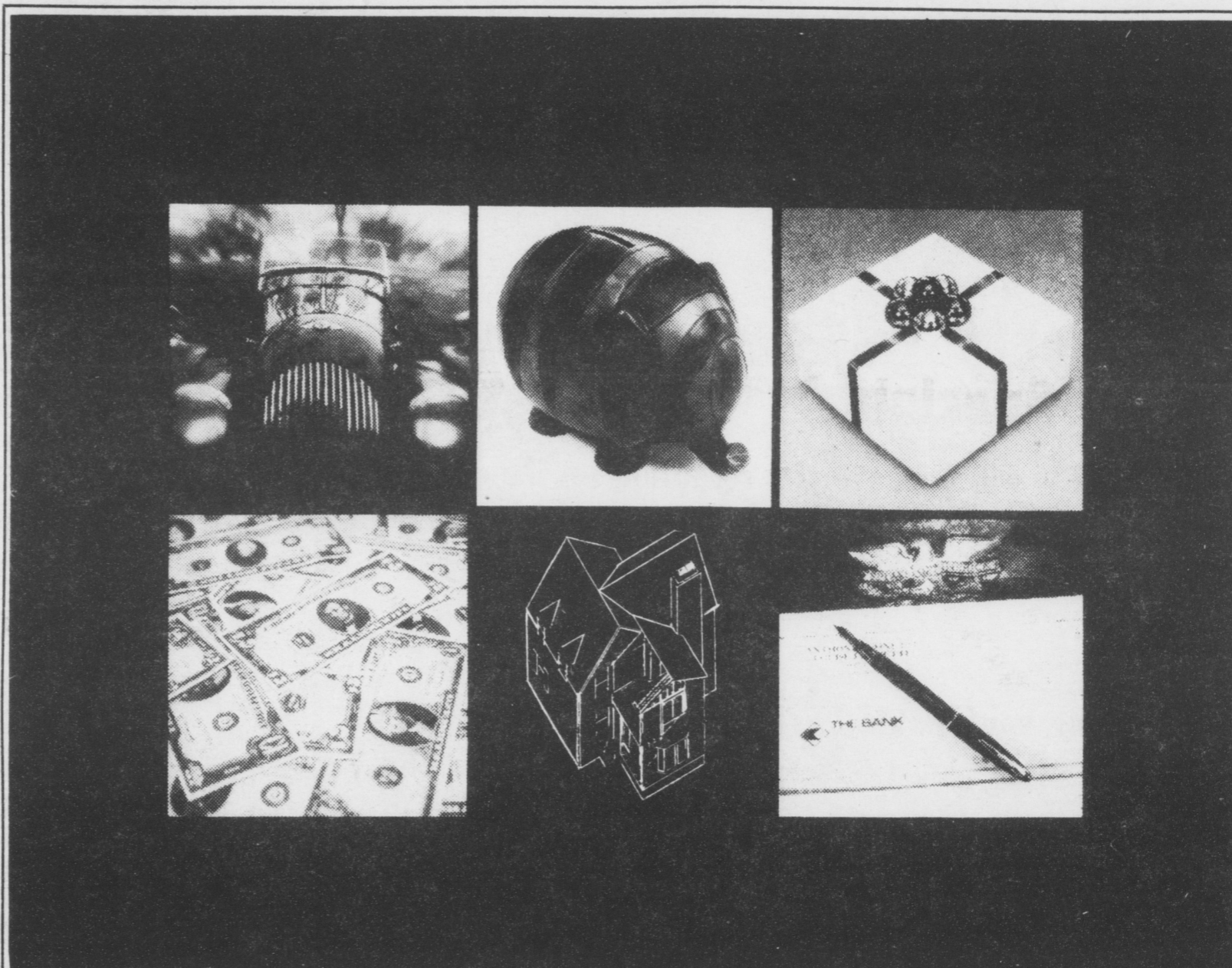
Come to Seiler School's Home Fashion Show on Tuesday, Feb. 28th. A brief business meeting begins at 7:00 PM, followed by a

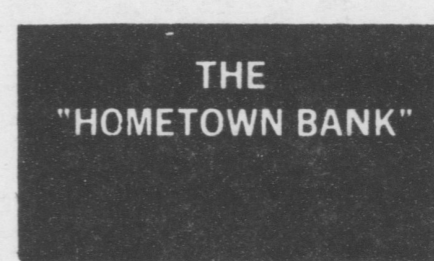
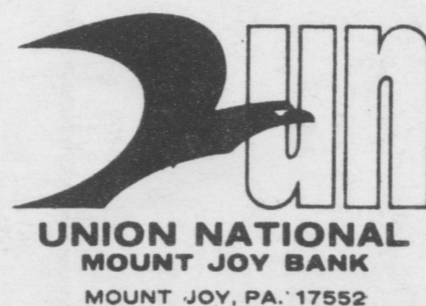
