Boy & Girl of the Month at DHS

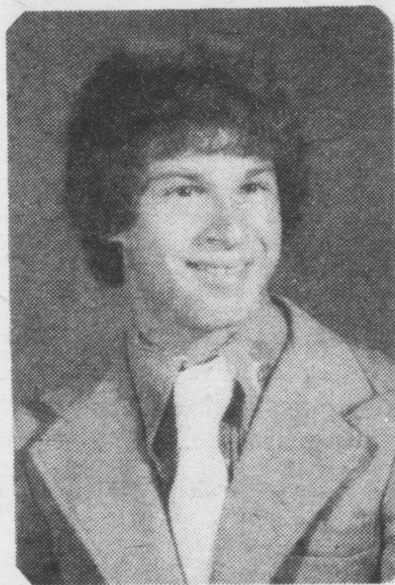


Jolene Lindemuth
