that a house must be water -tight: drains would have to be fitted with one-way valves to prevent backup of flood waters into the house, and all walls below the hundred year flood line would have to be waterproof. This can be done, it seems, but is most likely rather expensive.

As to Marietta's expected Historic District status, it guarantees that houses in the district could not be forced to be torn down, even if Marietta Borough passed such an ordinance. As for retroactive "floodproofing," it would probably apply to new structures (as we understand it at this point in our investigation), but not to any standing structure.

The Historic District will include all of Front Street and much of Market Street. Houses lining East Market are not in the District.

The Times hopes to keep its readers informed as this matter is investigated.
