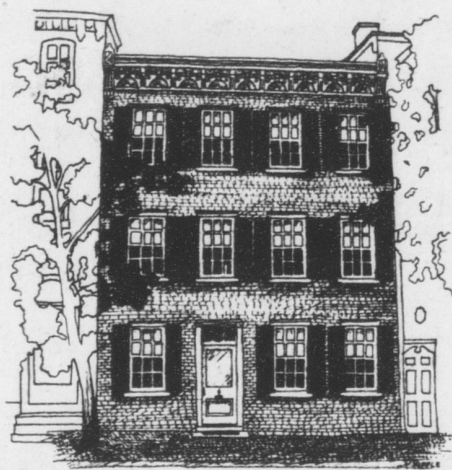
Ted will perform in several numbers during the performances. Previously he danced in *Aida* with the Pittsburgh Opera.

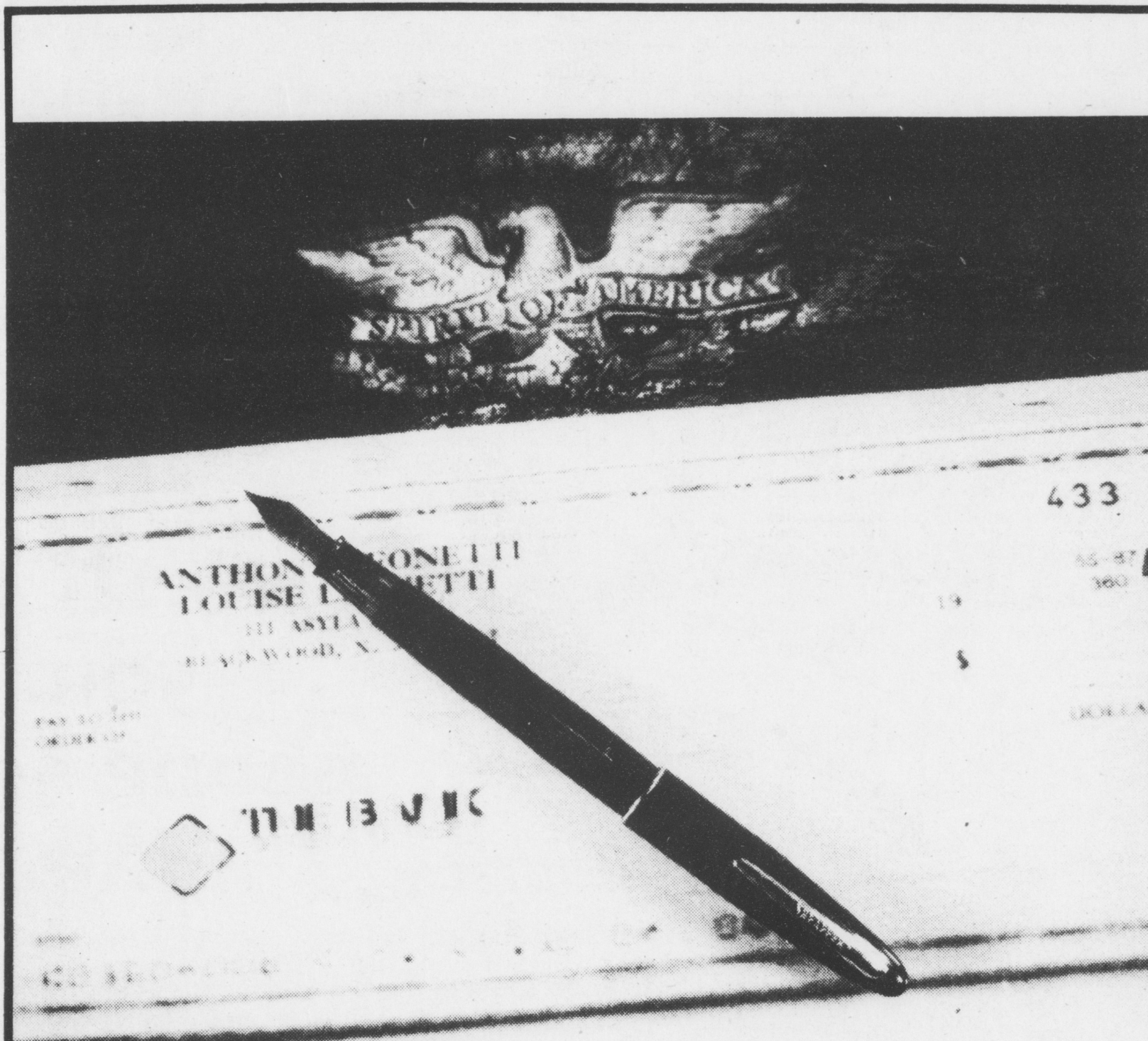

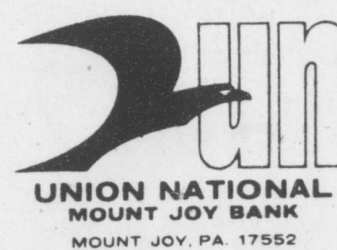
