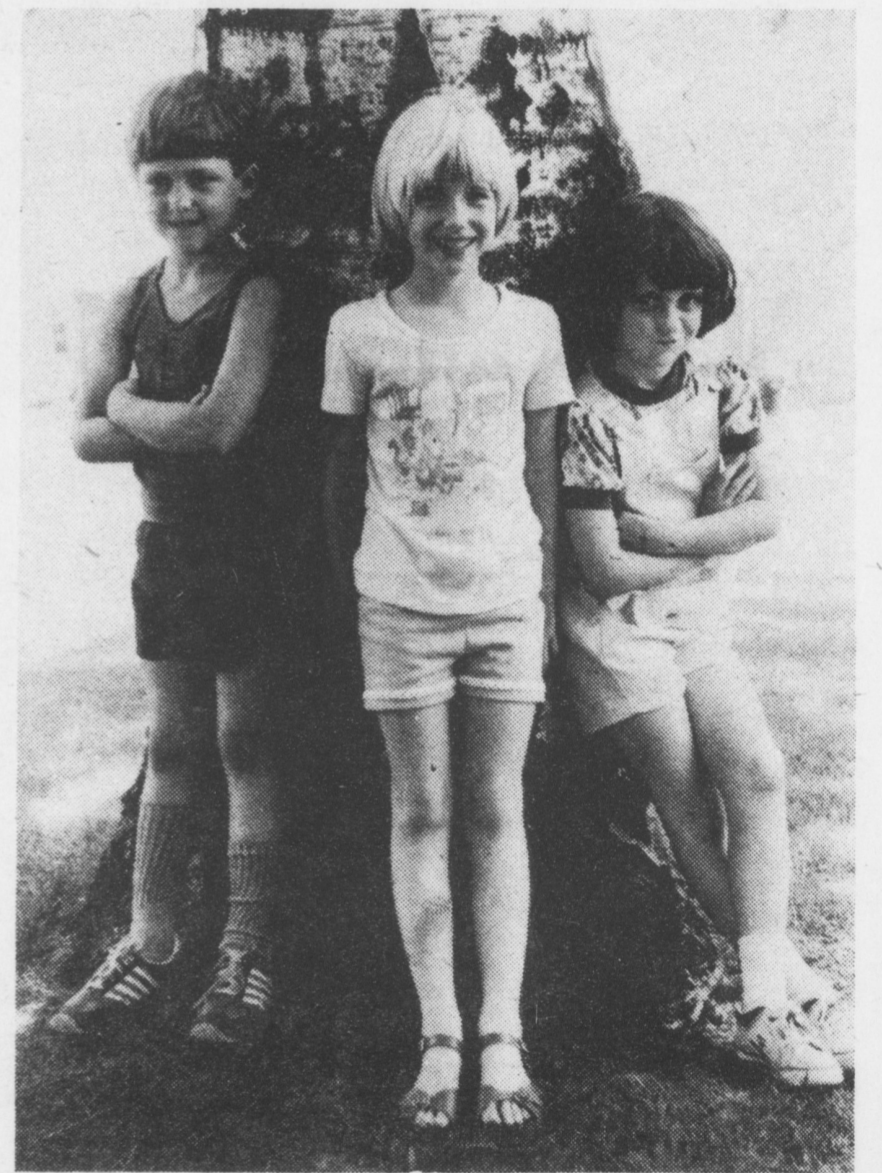
Winners of project S.H.A.R.E. awards at Maytown Elementary School are shown in these photos.
