

Mixed Doubles


Perfect weather and outstanding tennis competition contributed to the success of the 4th annual Mount Joy mixed doubles tournament held on Memorial Day weekend.

The proposed agenda for the Mount Joy Borough Council meeting to be held on Monday, June 12th, at 7:30 in the Borough Office is as follows:


1. Review the locations of stop signs.


2. Consider awarding bids for storm sewer construction at Delta St.
