Emerson Brandt, RD2 Mount Joy.

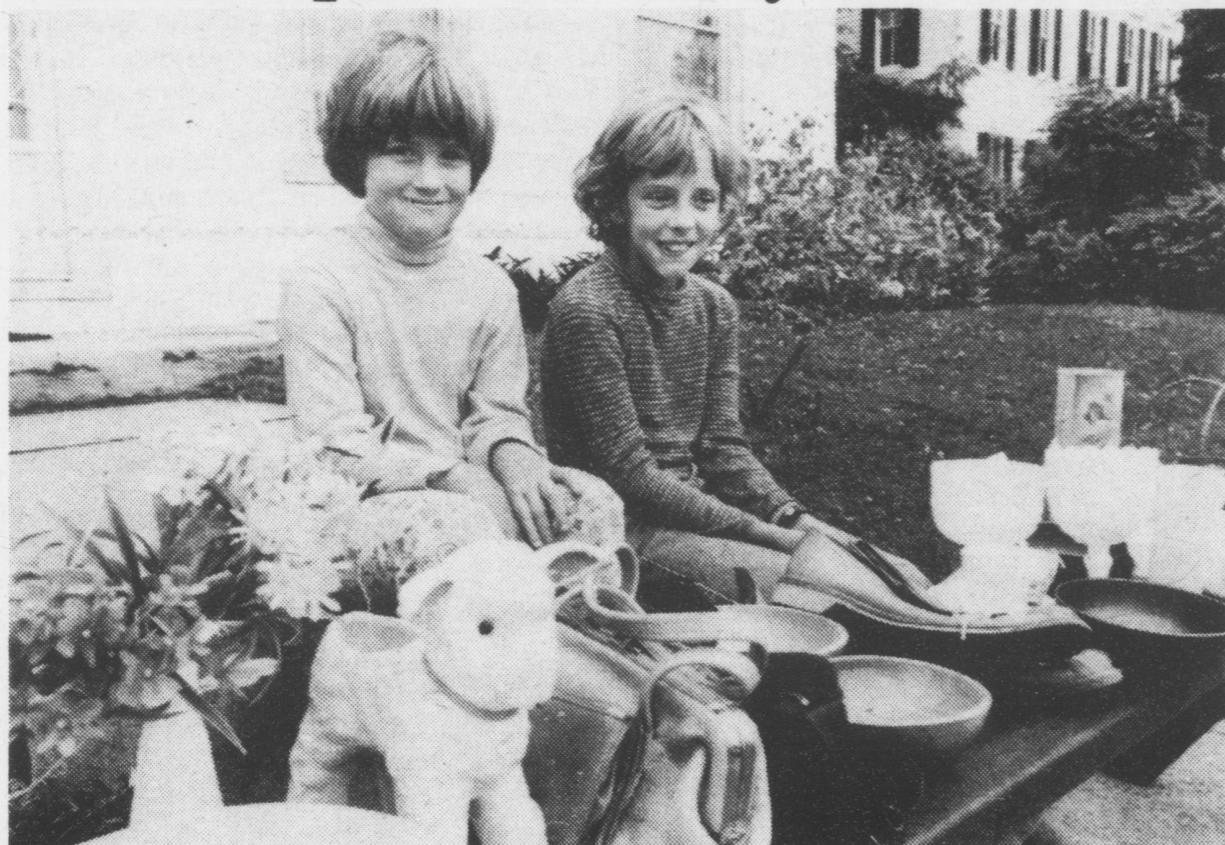
The bride-elect was graduated from Donegal High School this year. She is employed by Lancaster Limousine Service of Mount Joy.
